MPE CALCULATION for -4 dBi ANTENNA

Formula used in the MPE Calculations:

$$E^2/3770 = S, \text{ mW/cm}^2$$

$$\text{Pwatts} * \text{Ggain} = 10^{(\text{PdBm}-30+\text{GdBi})/10}$$

$$E, \text{ V/m} = (\text{Pwatts} * \text{Ggain} * 30)^{.5} / d, \text{ meters}$$

$$d = ((\text{Pwatts} * \text{G} * 30) / (3770 * S))^{.5} \text{ ----- (A)}$$

Since

$$S (\text{mW/cm}^2) = 0.30 \quad \text{from 1.1310 Table 1}$$

$$P (\text{dBm}) = 22.95 \quad \text{EUT output power}$$

$$G (\text{dBi}) = -4.00 \quad \text{EUT antenna gain}$$

Substitute these parameters into the A above, we have

$$\text{MPE safe distance } d (\text{cm}) = 4.6$$

NOTE: For mobile or fixed location transmitters, minimum separation distance is 20 cm, even if calculations indicate MPE distance is less
