



SPC5161 RGB Alarm Clock

Thank for your purchase of this quality clock. The utmost care has gone into the design and manufacture of your clock. Please read these instructions and store them in a safe place for future reference.

Getting Started

Connect the power cord into the back of the clock, and the other end into a USB power outlet, or a standard electrical outlet using the included power adapter. The display will turn on. Your clock is now ready to be set.

Important: Use ONLY 5V 1A or 5V 2A power adapter or USB power sources.

Setting the TIME

- Press and hold the **TIME** button down for two seconds to activate time setting, the hour digit will blink.
- Press the **UP** or **DOWN** button to advance to the correct hour.
- Press the **UP** or **DOWN** button to advance to the correct minute and press the **TIME** button to confirm, the time is now set.

Setting the ALARM

- Press and hold the **ALARM 1/2** button down for two seconds to activate **ALARM 1/2** setting, hour digit will blink.
- Press the **UP** or **DOWN** button to advance to the correct hour.
- Press the **UP** or **DOWN** button to advance to the correct minute and press the **ALARM 1/2** button to confirm, the alarm time is now set.

Using the ALARM

- Press the **ALARM 1/2** button to activate the alarm and the alarm indicator will light up.
- The **BEEP** will come on at the set time.
- To stop the alarm, press the **ALARM 1/2** button. The alarm will sound again the next day.
- To turn the alarm off completely, press the **ALARM 1/2** button until the alarm indicator is no longer visible.

BLUETOOTH Function

- Press the **MUSIC** button to enter Bluetooth mode, using the native controls on your Bluetooth device and select "SPC5161" in your Bluetooth settings to pair.
- When successfully paired and connected, the alarm clock will sound "**CONNECTED**" and you can use the connected Bluetooth device to select a track.
- To play, skip or pause the selected track, use the native controls on the connected Bluetooth device.
- To adjust the volume, press the **UP** or **DOWN** button on the alarm clock.
- To turn off the music, press and hold the **MUSIC** button.

SLEEP SOUNDS Function

- Press the **MUSIC** button to enter **MUSIC** mode, press again the **MUSIC** button to select different sleep sounds (rain, thunderstorm, water, frogs, bird, ocean waves).
- To adjust the volume, press the **UP** or **DOWN** button on the alarm clock.
- To turn off the music, press and hold the **MUSIC** button.

RGB Light Function

- Press and hold the **RGB LIGHT** button to turn on the RGB light.
- Press the **RGB LIGHT** button to change light (RGB, warm white, red, blue, green, cyan, purple, teal, yellow).
- To turn it off, press and hold the **RGB LIGHT** button.

SNOOZE, DIMMER & SLEEP Function

SNOOZE

- When the alarm sounds, press the **SNOOZE** button to pause the alarm, the alarm indicator will flash & sound again in 9 minutes.

DIMMER

- To adjust the display brightness, press the **DIMMER** button to select between HIGH, MEDIUM or OFF.

Note: The default is HIGH display brightness.

SLEEP

- When the alarm clock is in **BLUETOOTH** or **MUSIC** mode, press the **SLEEP** button repeatedly to select the duration: 15, 30, 60 minutes.
- At the end of the set time, the music will turn off automatically.
- To cancel the sleep function before the end of the set time, press the **SLEEP** button until the sleep indicator no longer visible.

Battery Precautions

- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended are to be used.
- Batteries are to be inserted with the correct polarity.
- The supply terminals are not to be short-circuited.
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire. Batteries may explode or leak.
