Re: S1 (SND321) FCC Certification – Declarations for SAR Compliance

In response to your request for further information regarding Body Worn SAR compliance, of the phone case (pouch), please be advised as follows:

1. S1 Hands free PHF and clip part numbers:

- a) Belt Clip: 8P18-60000-00000
- b) Hands Free PHF: 8P14-02000-20003

2. Belt Clip – Metal content

The plastic belt clip on the back of the phone case, tested with the phone for SAR compliance, contains a small metal clip. The clips provides the spring tension within the clip.

3. Separation of Case from Body – Belt clip thickness.

The dimension of the clip, which provides separation between the user's body and the case, is 14mm, plus a small gap between the clip and body of 1mm. Hence the total separation is 15mm, which aligns with the Sendo User Manual statement of 1.5cm.

4. Orientation of Case:

For the PSB/Singapore SAR report provided, the phone was tested for SAR with the case in the following orientation.

- Screen at top, keypad facing away from the body.

This is the only orientation applicable to the phone/case combination, as the PHF port is only accessible through the hole in the bottom of the case, connecting to the bottom of the phone, and the display facing out through the clear plastic window. Photographs demonstrating the construction of the case were provided 19th May 2005.

5. User Manual FCC Statement

We confirm that the FCC statement on page iv of the User manual will be enhance to fully incorporate the CFR4747CFR15.19 (a) (3), before any shipments to the USA occur. This will include the following text:

"This device complies with part 15 of the FCC rules. Operation is subject to the following two conditions: (1) This device may not cause harmful interference, and (2) this device must accept any interference received, including interference that may cause undeserved operation."

NB: This text will be included within all manuals, including those for the S1 (SND321) and S601 (Rev7) currently undergoing BABTPS FCC/TCB certification.

6. User Manual Addendum

Until such a time as Sendo complete a Class 2 TCB change/update, to include Body warn SAR compliance with zero separation distance for use of the phone with a neck strap, Sendo will include an addendum sheet with all standard User Manuals destined for the USA market, with the following statement:

Addendum to Page of the User manual:

"Lanyard Neck Strap:"

"The lanyard feature for attachment of a neck strap is not approved for use in the USA."

We trust that this fully addresses all outstanding issues in order for BABTPS to complete the TCB assessment for the S1 (SND321) GSM phone, and also the S601 Rev 7 to follow.
