

This application is for a family of remote controls. Differences between SUITE Arc and Step remote control are as follows:

STEP: A single channel remote with three operating buttons and a ""SUITE"" button. These will Open/Stop/Close a single motor. The "SUITE" button will send an intermediate position movement.

ARC: A 4 channel remote with three operating buttons and a "SUITE" Button. These will Open/Stop/Close a single motor. The "SUITE" button will administer an intermediate position movement. To select which motor or group of motors a person would wish to operate, you will press a number across the top of the remote. This will activate an LED. When activated, the remote will output that channel

Both remotes use the same RF circuitry, the only difference is the number of buttons and the software. The ARC model is what was tested.
