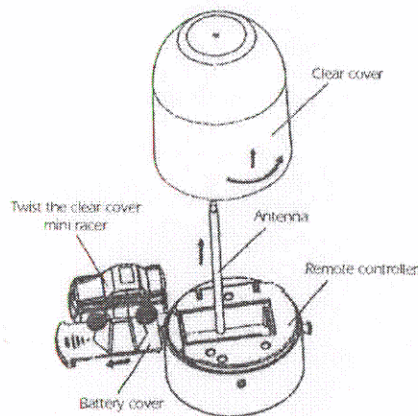
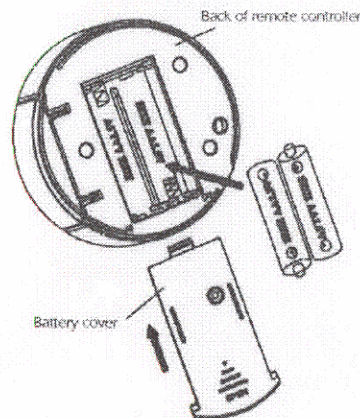


# Mini GT Racer

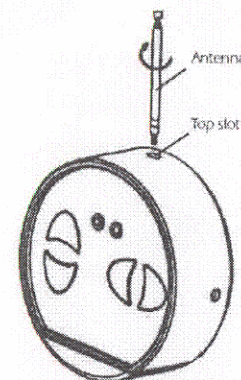
1. Twist the clear cover to the left, slide out the antenna and remove the battery cover.



2. Insert 2pcs AA size batteries and replace the battery cover properly



3. Screw in the antenna into the top slot of the remote controller

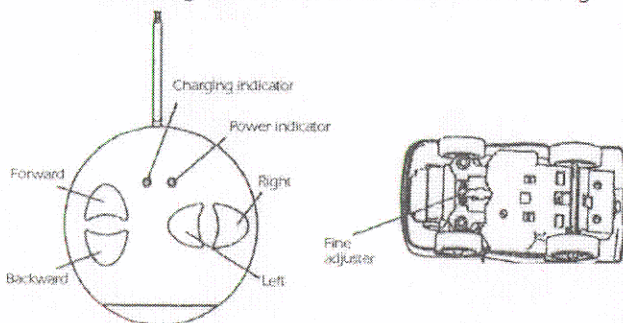


This device complies with Part 15 of the FCC Rules. Operation is subject to the following two conditions:

## Operating direction:

1. The remote controller has auto power off feature, there is no need ON/OFF switch necessary. When pressing any button, the red color Power indicator will ON. If the light turn dark, it means the batteries dried and need to replace a new batteries.
2. Please extend the antenna to the longest level to achieve the best reception for Mini Racer
3. There are 4 main buttons to control Mini Racer, "Forward", "Backward", "Left" & "Right". But "Forward" and "Backward" OR "Left" and "Right" cannot press at the same time.
4. The fine adjuster is located at the back of Mini Racer which allows fine alignment made on Mini Racer to runs straight.

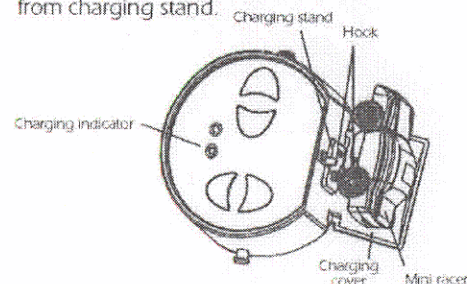


## Caution:

1. When batteries power at low level, the MiniRacer will slow down. It needs to replace new batteries.
2. The Mini Racer may shaky when switching Forward or Backward direction.

## Charging the Mini Racer

1. Open the Charging cover upward
2. Place the Mini Racer into the Charging stand
3. Ensure the Mini Racer in Lock position
4. The Charging Indicator will light ON
5. When charging process completed, the Charging Indicator will light OFF automatically. You can remove the Mini Racer from charging stand.



\*If continue charging Mini Racer when Charging Indicator lights OFF, the usage time may be extend more.
