


This baby monitor meets all standards related to electromagnetic fields and safe-use when operating in accordance with the instructions of user guide. Therefore, please read the user guide carefully before using the device.

- · Must be assembled by an adult.
- This baby monitor can be used for adult guardianship.
- Store this user guide for future reference.
- Do not cover the baby monitor with towel or blanket.
- · Keep the baby monitor away from water.
- Keep the baby monitor away from heater, humidifier & others.
- Do not use other charger or power adaptor which may damage the device.
- Do not touch the plug with a sharp or metal object.

IMPORTANT NOTES FOR INSTALLING A BABY MONITOR

- When using, must check if the wireless Transmission is smoothly connected between camera and the displayer. The wireless Transmission distance is affected by environmental conditions.
- Any heavy metal objects or home appliances will block wireless signal transmission, such as refrigerators, metal doors, or reinforced concrete.
- The strength of the signal may be attenuated by solid buildings (such as walls), radios or electrical equipment (such as televisions, computers).

- If the signal is lost, try to move the device to a different location indoors.
- Do not put monitor and camera together within 1.5 meters, otherwise, it will cause howling.

USING YOUR BABY MONITOR



Getting Started

1. Plugging in the Camera

Connect the camera to the 5V DC power supply with the included AC adapter. The camera will automatically power on. Approximately 15 seconds later, you will hear a notification sound indicating that the camera has successfully powered on.





Place the camera and power cord out of reach of children. Camera is not battery powered. Keep plugged in when in use.

2. Charging the Monitor

It takes around 4 hours to fully charge. The power indicator will turn red while charging and turn green when fully charged.



It takes around 7 hours to fully charge. The charging indicator will turn on while charging and off when fully charged.



3. Pairing the Camera with the Monitor

By default, the camera has been paired with the monitor when manufactured. If the camera is disconnected, please refer to page 12.



Keep camera and monitor within a distance of 12-40 in (30-100cm) when pairing. Note that microphone feedback might occur when they are close to each other.

4. Positioning the Camera

Keep the camera 3-16 ft (1-5m) away from your baby's crib, playpen and baby bed for best viewing and safety reasons.

5. Wall Mounting the Camera (Optional)

Select a spot to mount the camera, ideally 5-8 ft high, keeping it beyond the reach of children. Install the included screw into the wall and mount the camera onto the screw.




Do not release the camera until you're sure it is firmly mounted.








3. Lullaby

Press , select through , and press , and press , and press to select lullabies and play mode. Press ok to play the lullaby. The first three tracks are white noise, and the following five tracks are lullabies.



4. Brightness Settings

- · Press , select through → Brightness , and press / Let to adjust degree → OK to set the desired brightness level.
 - · Short press OK , and press ♠ / ♥ to adjust degree → OK to set the desired brightness level.










6. Add a Camera

Press \bigcirc , select through \bigcirc \bigcirc

camera near the antenna and listen for the prompt tone, then the camera will pair with the monitor automatically.





7. View a Camera

Press (☐), select through (☐) → (☐) Cam View , and select the camera number 1/2 to view.



8. Delete a Camera

Press (\equiv) , select through \bigcirc \rightarrow $\overline{\mathbb{U}}$ Delete , and select the camera number 1/2 to view.

At least one camera should stay connected.

The current camera number will appear at the top of the screen.

If you want to remove the remaining camera, press the PAIR button three times to disconnect it, and then you can delete the remaining camera.



9. Auto Switch



Once set, the screen will automatically switch from one camera to another camera (if connected) every 15 seconds.



10. Split Screen

Once two cameras are selected, you can view two cameras in split-screen mode. In split-screen mode, the audio will switch between cameras every 15 seconds.

11. VOX (Voice Activated Alert)

1) Press (≡), select through →

2) choose a sensitivity level. The higher the VOX sensitivity level, the more sensitive the camera is in detecting sounds for transmitting to the monitor.



Once set, the screen will go into sleep and enter VOX mode. In VOX mode, the screen will stop broadcasting sounds from the camera side until the audio detected is above the alert level.



12. Nursing Reminder

→ Reminder, press (▲) / (♣) Press (≡), select through to select the group, you can set up to four alarms → (OK) to set a specific time for the monitor to alert you for Repeat, and select 2 hours, 4 hours, nursing. You can also select through or 6 hours to create a repeating reminder.

The reminder will sound for 30 seconds and again after 1 minute if no action is taken, but will shut off automatically if none is taken after three times.









Note: App can only access camera when wifi is ON.

14. Detection

- 1) Crying Detection
- · Press (≡), select through (§) → (Crying Detection) to turn on/off detection.

Monitor will alert you when detect the baby's cry.





- Press (≡), select through (§) → [§] Motion Detection to select High / Middle /
 - Low / OFF sensitivity levels to monitor your baby's movements.

For example, select high sensitivity while your baby is sleeping to receive alerts for any movement. For an awake and playing baby, choose medium or low sensitivity.



The camera continuously tracks your baby, ensuring they remain in your sight.


Push (99) to talk and release to listen.



16. Sleep Mode


Short press (1) to enter sleep mode. Press any button to wake up.

In sleep mode, the screen will turn off, but the monitor will continue to receive sounds from the camera. At the same time, if the camera detects any abnormal condition, the monitor will be awakened.





17. Zoom In & Zoom Out




19. Night Vision



Add camera

Step 1: Connect your Phone to a 2.4GHz Wi-Fi Network

- For optimal performance, ensure that your device has a strong wireless signal. Additionally, please confirm that your Wi-Fi network is 2.4GHz, as 5GHz Wi-Fi is not supported.

Step 2: Download and Install the BB CAM App

- Ensure that your phone is compatible with the BB CAM app. Scan the QR code to download and install the BB CAM app. You can also search for "BB CAM" in the Apple App Store or Google Play Store.



- To receive immediate updates about your children, please allow BB CAM to send notifications to your device. Additionally, enable BB CAM to access Wi-Fi and wireless data networks.
- Allow the BB CAM app to use wireless data.

Step 3: Sign Into Your BB CAM Account

- If you don't have a BB CAM account, please tap "Register" to create one. Choose your country or region and enter your email address and password, then tap "Send" to receive a verification code. If you do not receive the code within 60 seconds, you can request a new one.
- If you already have an account, tap "Login" to interact with your baby.

Step 4: Pair the Camera with Your Phone

- 1. Before adding the camera, ensure that your phone is connected to a 2.4GHz Wi-Fi network. Also, allow BB CAM to find and connect to devices on your local network.
- 2. Tap "Add Device."











- 3. Allow BB CAM to access your location and use Bluetooth
- 4. Enter the Wi-Fi information to which your phone is connected.
- 5. Select the device you want to pair with your phone.






- 6. Press and hold the Reset button near the camera antenna for 5 seconds. When you hear the "DIDI" prompt tone, click "Next".
- 7. Your device will be found immediately. Tap "Add" and enter the password for the Wi-Fi network to which your phone is connected. Otherwise, you will not be able to link your phone to the device.
- 8. When you hear the prompt tone, your device has been set up successfully, and you will be able to see your baby monitor on the homepage.



- 9. You can now interact with your baby anytime and anywhere!
- If you have another camera to pair, simply tap "Add Device" and follow the steps outlined above.





Function & operation

1. Volume Setting

· Lullaby Volume

Press \triangleq select through $\diamondsuit \rightarrow \blacktriangleleft$) and Pull the bar to adjust the volume.

Device Volume

On the live page, press key ••• select through **Sounds** and pull the bar to adjust the volume.

· If the sound is still too low, you can adjust the volume on the phone itself.

Note: The volume of the lullaby is synchronized with the device's volume.

2. Lullaby

On the live view page, press ≘ select through ❖ → and press ♣ , select "Time interval" or "Timing" "Time interval" mean you set a duration, app will remind you after a duration from now. "Timing" means that app will remind you at the time you set.

6. Privacy Mode



17. Offline Notification

On the live page, press key ••• select through **Offline Notification** to turn on.

Cameras settings

1. Select room-by-room view and name cameras

On the live page, press key ••• select through Camera 1, you can rename the cameras and categorize them into the appropriate rooms.

2. Share cameras to your families

On the live page, press key ••• select through **Share Device** and select a sharing method, such as sharing via account, link, etc.

You can see who was shared the cameras.



3. Enable video watermark

On the live page, press key $\bullet \bullet \bullet$ select through **Basic Function Settings** \to **Time Watermark** to turn on.

4. Turn on Offline Notification

On the live page, press key ••• select **Offline Notification** to turn on Offline Notification.

5. Remove camera

Note: Once you remove the camera, no one in your created Home could access the camera.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Why won't my baby monitor turn on?

- Make sure the monitor is turned on and there is still power left.
- · Charge with the included power cable only.
- · Check if the charging indicator is on.

If not, please switch to another power outlet or change the adapter.

Is a WiFi connection required to set up and use?

- This non-WiFi appliance does not need an internet connection for setup.
- The baby monitor and camera use 2,4GHz radio frequency for transmission.

Why won't my baby monitor connect to the camera?

- Make sure the camera is securely plugged in. Check if the plug and power cord are damaged.
- Make sure the monitor is close to the camera when pairing.
- Check if there are large metallic objects like doors,
- refrigerators, mirrors that might block signal transmission.
 Check if there are existing 2.4GHz equipment like WiFi
- networks and microwave ovens that might interfere with signal transmission.
- Press the Menu Button, select through

 □ →

 □ Add → +

 and press the PAIR button on the camera, then the camera
 will pair with the monitor automatically.

Why does the monitor screen keep switching off when I'm using it?

• Press the Menu Button, select through → Screen Timeout and press ()/ → ○ to set the desired time for the screen to turn off automatically.

• You may have the VOX (Voice Activated Alert) mode on so that the screen will only come on when the sound is above the alert level

You can switch this feature off within the menu

Why is the screen black when I view a camera?

- Make sure the camera is in range and securely plugged in
- · Check if the plug and power cord are damaged.
- Adjust the monitor antenna to improve the signal strength.

Why is there no sound from the monitor?

- Check if the video volume is too low. Press the Menu Button, select through

 →

 Video Volume , and press

 →

 Cisk to set the desired volume level.
- Check if VoX mode is turned on. Note that in VOX mode the screen will stop broadcasting sounds from the camera side until the audio detected is above the alert level.

How should I clean and maintain my monitor and accesssories?

- Never immerse in water or other liquids. They are not waterproof.
- Clean with a dry cloth only. Exercise caution when cleaning the camera lens
- Clean the temperature sensor on the camera with a dry cotton swab on a regular basis.

Why is the temperature shown on the monitor not accurate?

Why did the monitor video suddenly turn black and white?

Why is the screen a bit choppy?

My baby monitor makes a noise.

- The temperature sensor is on the camera. Please make sure there is enough air circulation around the sensor.
- Do not place the camera near heat sources, including heaters, air-conditioning vents, and lamps.
- The air at the ceiling is warmer than the air at the floor. Place the camera at a relatively low height to read the temperature more accurately.
- Power the monitor and camera off and on again, reset the monitor to factory settings, and pair the camera with the monitor again.
- Night vision may have become activated. Turn on the room lights and night vision will turn off automatically.
- · Make sure the camera is in range.
- · Adjust the monitor antenna to improve the signal strength.
- Microphone feedback might occur when the monitor is too close to the camera. Keep them away from each other.
- The camera is not in range. Please keep the distance within 30 feet / 10 meters.
