

IMPORTANT NOTICE & SAFETY INFORMATION

Your WIRELESS network device contains a low power transmitter. When the device is in use it sends out radio frequency (RF) signals. This device is authorized to operate at a distance of at LEAST 20cm(7.9 inches) from the body. In August 1996, the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) adopted RF exposure guidelines with safety levels for wireless devices.
