

Guide usagé, configuration et opération

1. Alimenter le xTagDislay avec un câble USB ou une alimentation externe (9-24VDC)
2. Pour les capteurs câblés, en respectant le protocole de communication 1-wire, brancher le capteur via le connecteur RJ12 ou celui du bornier de 6 pins. Visualiser les données de sur l'écran du xTagDisplay.
3. Pour les capteurs RF, xTag2. Pressez et tenez les deux boutons présents sur le xTag2 jusqu'à ce qu'il s'allume. Une fois la communication établie avec le xTagDisplay, visualiser les données du xTag2 l'écran du xTagDisplay.
