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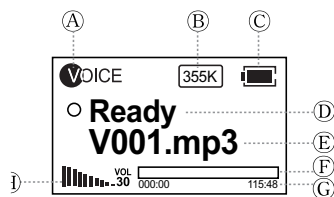

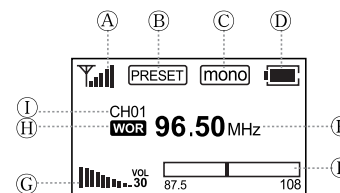

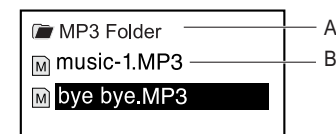

About Power

1. When initially turning on the product, the battery status may vary. It is stabilized 5 to 6 seconds after the power ON.



2. According to its characteristic, when using commonly used battery, the player may not work even with the battery capacity display in its medium position. Replace the battery. (Alkaline battery lasts longer than Manganese battery.)

3. Continuous play hours

- ① 1 battery: 15 hours (AAA alkaline)
- ② MP3 : 128Kbps
- ③ with Vol 15, Normal
- ④ Above result is subject to variation according to the type, the manufacturer and the use condition of battery.



※Replace the battery in case with the following symptoms;

- ① “Low Battery” displayed on LCD.
- ② Button is not functioning or stops its function soon after the trial.
- ③ LCD does not activate at the pressing of any button.

USB Connection

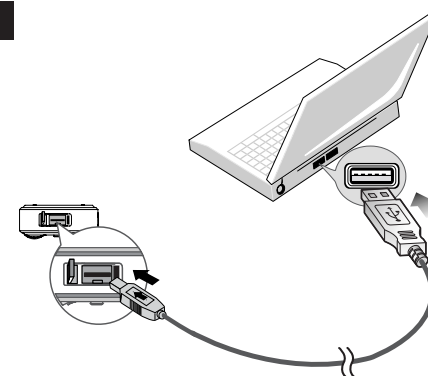


- What's USB (Universal Serial Bus)? This is a new connection system between PC and peripheral devices.
- Connect the USB cable supplied with the product into a USB port in PC. Any unexpected error can be happened when connecting to the USB port in front of PC or USB hub.
- The product can not be identified in the PC with Windows 98SE or lower. Install program CD supplied with the product in the PC.

Connection with USB cable

- 1** Open USB port cover on the back.

- 2** Connect between PC and the product using the USB cable supplied in the package.



USB Disconnection

■ In case with Windows ME, 2000 and XP;

- 1 Double click on the green arrow on the right-bottom part of the initial Window screen.



- 2 Click on Stop and OK after selecting "USB High Capacity Storage Device" and click on OK once again.



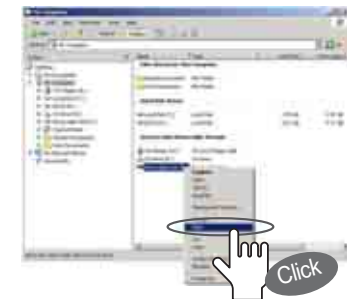
USB Disconnection

- 3 Click on OK on "Safety removal of the hardware" message bar and then remove the cable.



■ In case with Windows 98SE

Open "My Computer" or "Windows Search" and choose "Removable Disk." Choose "Remove" using the right button of mouse and then remove the USB cable.

- When no button manipulation in pause or stop condition is done for the set period time for "Auto Power Off," it automatically turns off the power.
- When you try to play a file by pressing after the restarting of the product, it completely recovers all previous setting. All track numbers, equalizer and other settings are recovered. (Resume function in second unit)

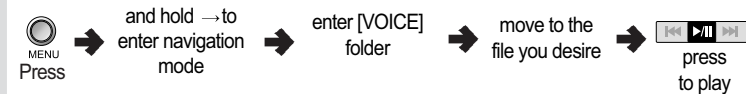

- In case that the power is not enough to run the product, the recording may not be completed correctly.

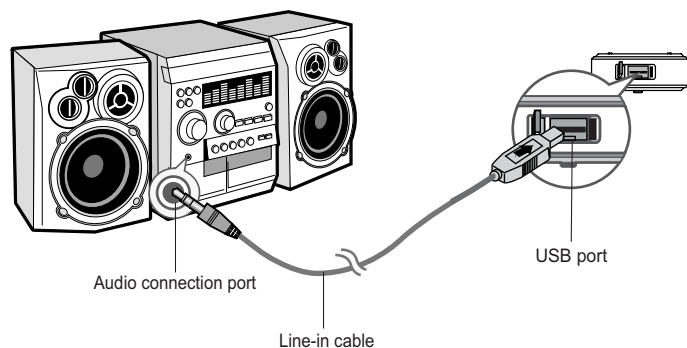

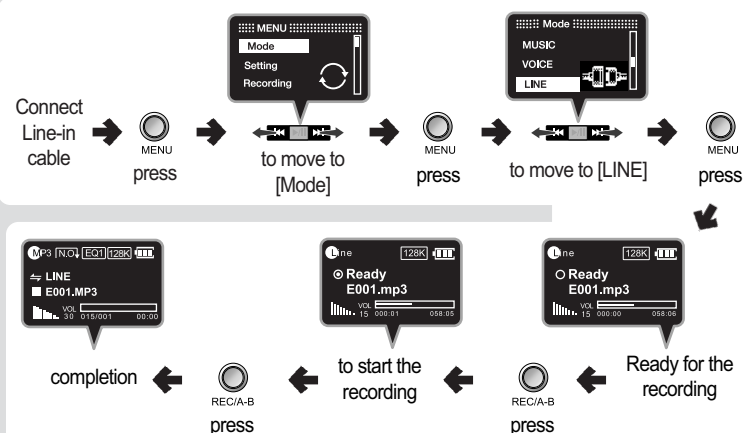

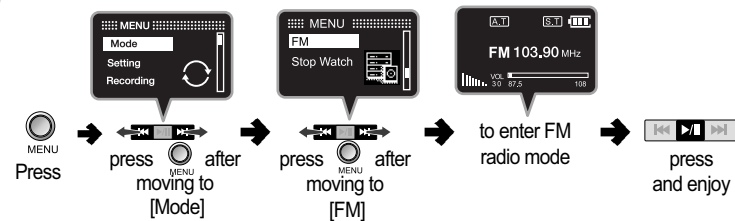

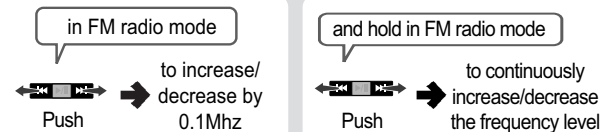

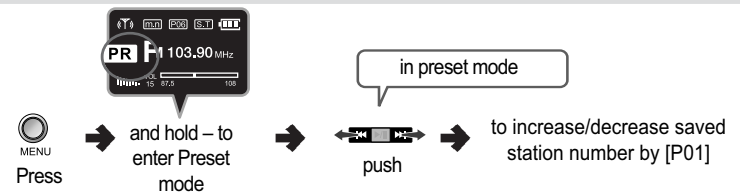

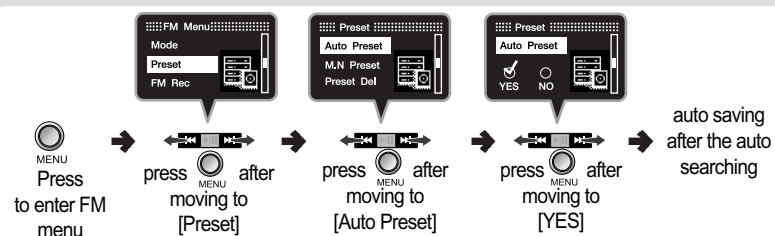

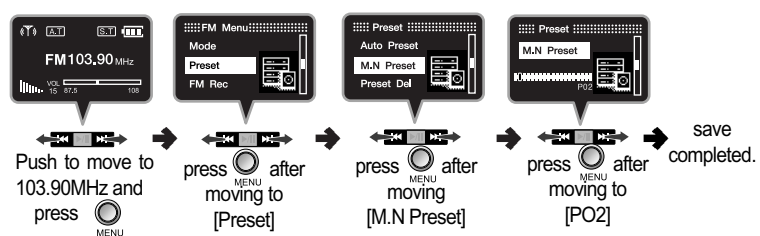

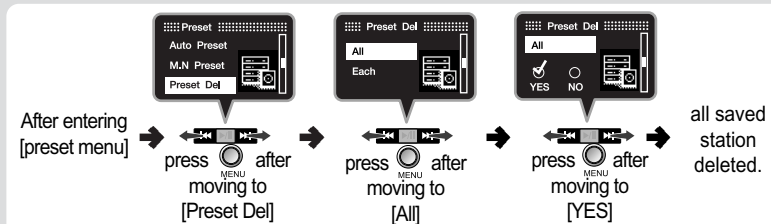

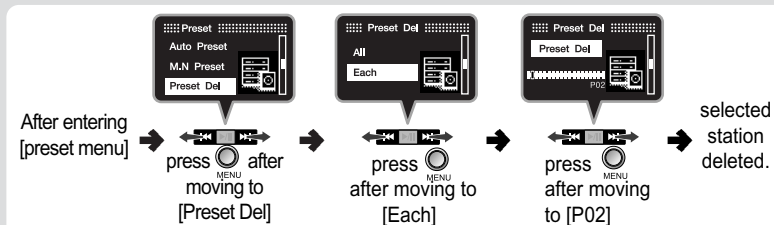

FM radio recording

- When the memory gets full the recording automatically stops and the file is recorded up-to-point.
- Sound quality may vary according to FM Bit rate
- In case that the power is not enough to run, the product the recording may not be completed correctly.

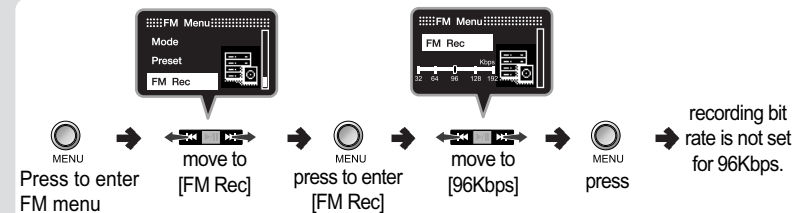
FM recording Bit rate setting



- Lower bit rate means higher compression rate with low sound quality while higher bit rate stands for vice versa.
- In FM recording, the bit rate can be set from 32, 64, 96 through to 128Kbps.

Download

- Pentium 200MHz or higher
- More than 32 MB of RAM (64 MB or more for Window ME or 2000).
- More than 128MB of Hard Disk Space
(Additional Disk Space is required for storing music files)
- USB Port (Ver. 1.1) Available

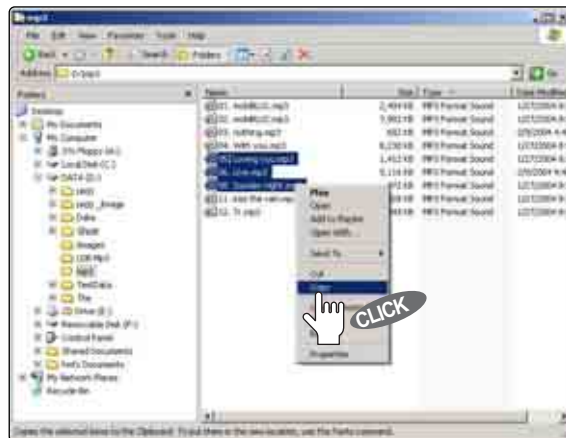
- The Program CD allows you to upload or download files without installing other additional software.
- For Windows 98SE Users: install the software first before using the player (otherwise, PC will not detect the player as a peripheral).
- For Windows 2000/ME/XP Users: install the provided program CD if you are upgrading Firmware

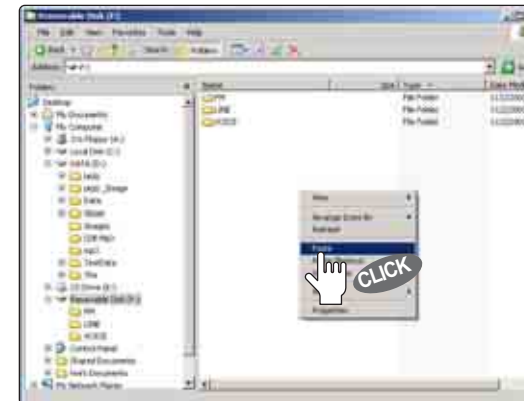
- This product can download or upload all types of data files (*.jpg, *.xls, *.hwp) functioning as a removable disk as well as a MP3 player.

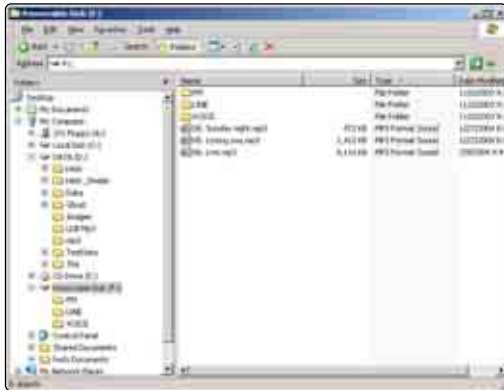

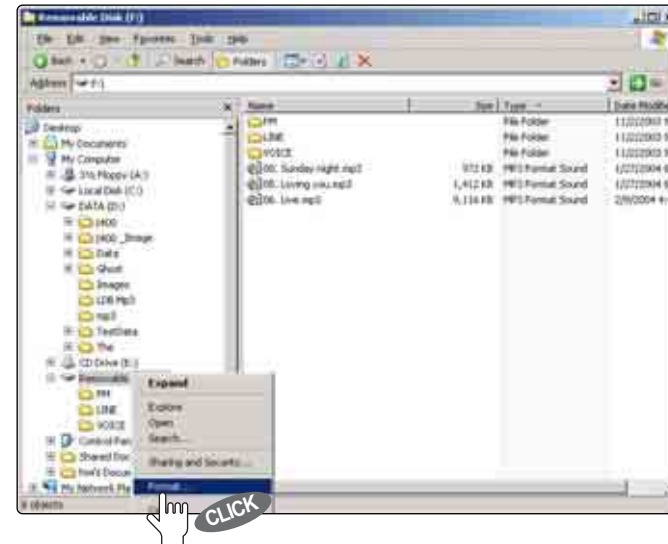
