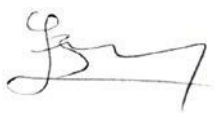

Attestation Letter for VLP (6VL) Module

We, **Intel Corporation**, attest that the equipment with FCC ID: **PD9BE201D2** complies with the following Very Low Power 6VL protocols and restrictions:

1. Device Protocol Attestation Statement:
 - a. This device will prioritize spectrum above 6.105 GHz.
 - b. This device will use Transmit Power Control {TPC}. The TPC mechanism of the device is not user-configurable and is governed by either signal sensitivity or the PERs indicator. Details of the mechanism is provided with the operational description.
2. Device Operating Restrictions:
 - a. This device is prohibited for control of or communication with unmanned aircraft systems, including drones.
 - b. Operation of this device is prohibited on oil platforms and aircraft, except that operation in the 5.925-6.425 GHz band is permitted in large aircraft flying above 10,000 feet.
