Front



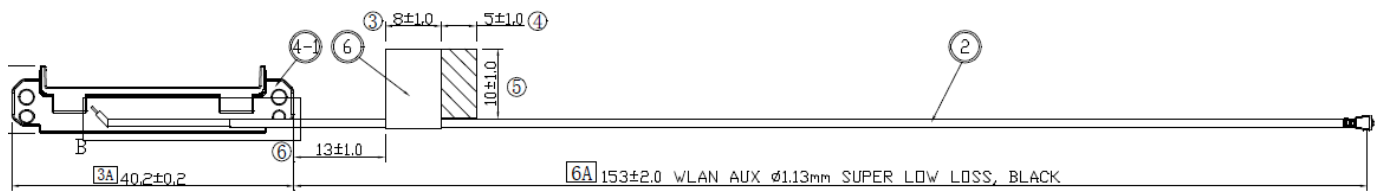

B.1 Antenna Host Platform Location Information

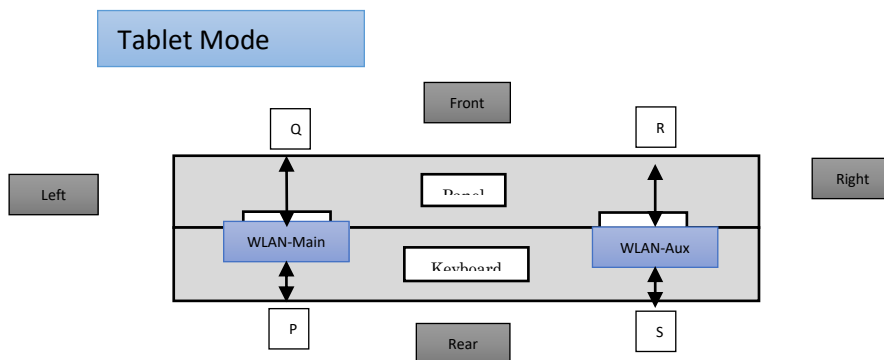

B.2 Antenna dimensional information for SAR evaluation
