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Declaration of SAR Exclusion Letter

According to KDB 447498 section 4.3.1, the 1-g SAR test exclusion thresholds at test separation distance ≤ 50 mm are determined by:

$$[(\text{max. power of channel, including tune-up tolerance, mW}) / (\text{min. test separation distance, mm})] * [\sqrt{f(\text{GHz})}] \leq 3.0$$

The tune-up power is 3.00 dBm +/- 0.5dB, therefore the highest tune-up power is

3.50 dBm (2.24 mW) @ 2440 MHz

When the minimum test separation distance is < 5 mm, a distance of 5 mm according to 5) in section 4.1 is applied to determine SAR test exclusion.

So,

$$((2.24 \text{ mW}) / 5\text{mm}) * (2.440\text{GHz})^{0.5} = 0.7$$

$$[(\text{max. power of channel, including tune-up tolerance, mW}) / (\text{min. test separation distance, mm})] * [\sqrt{f(\text{GHz})}] = 0.7 < 3.0$$

Therefore, standalone SAR measurements are not required for both head and body.
