

FCC RF Radiation Exposure Statement.

Your cordless telephone contains a low-power transmitter. During use it sends out radio frequency (RF) signals. This equipment complies with FCC RF radiation exposure limits set forth for an uncontrolled environment.

Caution: *To maintain compliance with the FCC's RF Exposure guidelines, hold the handset in such a manner as to maintain a separation distance of 0.5 inches (1.25 cm) between the antenna and your body with the antenna pointed up and away from your head. If you wear the handset on your body while using a headset accessory, use only the manufacturer's supplied belt clip for this product and ensure that the antenna is at least 1 inch (2.5 cm) from your body during use.*

Important Note:

Use only the supplied antenna. Unauthorized antennas, modifications, or attachments could damage the transmitter and may violate FCC regulations.
