DirectPad enables one-touch access to the Internet sites often visited by users, with buttons attached to a mouse pad.

DirectPad enables direct access to mail service application shortly after e-mail reception is notified by the e-mail indicator,

DirectPad gives convenience of Web surfing to netizens, an ease of the Internet use to beginners, and an efficient marketing media tool to companies.

Components

1. Installation CD
2. DirectPad (11Buttons & e-mail indicator, Port Connector)

Installation Guide

1. Connect DirectPad's Serial Connector to RS-232C Port, not used in your computer (desk-top or portable)
2. Insert the Installation CD into the CD-ROM drive, and the installation is automatically executed.
3. Complete to install a program following a guideline
4. Fill up mail server, user ID and password to configure mail environment of controlling program for DirectPad. (currently in POP3 only)
5. Press a check button for being confirmed.
(In case of appropriate configuration, the number of received mails is shown)

6. Input URLs of your favorite Internet sites in the preference.
7. Press the hide button to lay the controlling program out of sight.

; Double-click the Tray Icon to see the controlling program again.

The URLs in the preferences can be changed at any time, except for some pre-fixed sites

If you are using MS Office 2000 a check box will be shown for option
