

How to install and use the Alpha version

- You need to copy the content of the CD in a folder on you PC.
- Then click on the shortcut "Play Jungle Book open GL" if you have an Open GL graphic card like GeForce or click on the shortcut "Play Jungle Book 3Dfx" if you have a 3Dfx card like Voodoo2.

Key assignments

- **Single Player**
Player 1 uses the arrow pad to input arrows.
- **2 players (team play or versus)**
Player 1 uses the following keys W = up / S = down
A = left / D = right

Player 2 uses the arrow pad to input arrows
- In the menus use the ESC key to go back to previous page
- To quit a level, press the ESC key.
- To skip the kinematics, press ALT + F4 at any time during the kinematics.
- While in a level you can press F4 to activate a game pad.
