Please reexamine the radiated data on pp. 5 of your test report. 15.231(b)(2) appears to imply that emissions are to be expressed as average measurements using the techniques of 15.35 OR Quasi-Peak measurements, but not both. If Quasi-Peak is employed, then I question if the duty cycle correction of 11dB is justified.

Please review your test data again. All else looks OK with the Application
