Response to correspondence reference 23171.

1. In order to allow installation in mobile devices the following is proposed:-

a) The following statement is added to page 42 of the Reference Manual to be supplied to OEM's.

"A maximum antenna gain and cable loss of 3.6 dBI is required to meet the FCC RF exposure requirements.

When used in mobile devices with an antenna above this maximum gain or in portable devices, for example in handset and body-worn devices, a separate approval will be required from the FCC."
