 - E2K633ANH (WLAN Transmitter)
 - PD962205ANHU (WLAN Transmitter)
 - QDS-BRCM1049 (Bluetooth Transmitter)
- The E396 has two-way authentication implemented for user's installed modules.
- The P17G-P17G001 BIOS restricts the screen from rotating into an orientation that would position the WWAN antenna to be close to (touching) the user.
