AMETEK Drexelbrook intends to market fluid level measuring devices, the DR 22X0 and DR 3X00. These devices are manufactured by Krohne America Inc. as Krohne's model BM 702 and BM 70, respectively. Krohne received a grant of equipment authorization from the FCC for BM 702 (FCC ID JH5BM702) on October 11, 2000, and for the BM 70 (FCC ID JH5BM70), on February 2, 1993.

Krohne will continue to manufacture these devices and will sell them to AMETEK Drexelbrook. According to AMETEK Drexelbrook, other than labeling, the radar devices will not be modified in any way from the equipment authorized in the original grants to Krohne. The original test results are representative of and applicable to AMETEK's products.

Attached to this letter are photographs showing the exterior appearance of the equipment, including control features and labeling. Also attached are the original Krohne equipment authorization grants.
