## GETTING STARTED

#### **How to Operate your Headset Walkie Talkies**

- 1. The headset walkie talkies are just like a cordless telephone. It enables both parties to talk and listen at the same time.
- 2. Open the battery door and insert 2 "AA" batteries. (not included)
- 3. Select "Lo" or "Hi" volume by using the selector switch located on the side of your walkie talkies.
- 4. Adjust the headband and boom mic.
- 5. When transmitting, speak clearly using a normal tone.
- 6. Move to a different location in the event of interference caused by other radio signals in the vicinity.
- 7. Modifications not authorized by the manufacturer should not be made.

#### **Caring For Your Product:**

Your headset walkie talkies have been fully adjusted. Be sure not to touch any internal components other than the batteries:

- 1. If the sound or volume becomes weak, replace the batteries.
- 2. After use, always turn the selector switch to the "Off" position.
- 3. Keep your headset walkie talkies in a dry and clean place.
- 4. Please do not exert excessive force on the boom microphone or the headband of the unit.

#### How to Replace Batteries: Requires 2AA (LR6) alkaline batteries (not included)

ALWAYS have an adult install and change the batteries.


ALWAYS turn off the product when not in use.

- 1. Use a Phillips screwdriver to remove the battery door.
- 2. Install battery as shown in figure above.
- 3. After installing the batteries make sure the lid is screwed on securely so it does not come off.
