

HOW TO OPERATE

PUT BATTERIES IN THE TRANSMITTER AND THE CAR AS SHOWN IN FIGURE.

MAKE SURE ALL BATTERIES ARE AT THE CORRECT POLARITY.

- . TURN THE "ON-OFF" SWITCH AT THE BOTTOM OF THE CAR TO "ON" POSITION, THEN THE CAR WILLGO BACKWARD IN CIRCULAR PATH,
- PRESS THE BUTTON ON THE TRANSMITTER. THE CAR WILL RESPOND IN GOING STRAIGHT FORWARD.
- TO CHANGE DIECTION OF THE CAR, JUST RELEASE THE BUTTON, THE CAR WILL GO BACKWARD IN CIRCULAR PATH UNTIL THE CAR FACES THE DIRECTION AS YOU DESIRE, PRESS THE BUTTON AGAIN THE CAR WILL GO FORWARD IN THE DIRECTION AS YOU WANT,
