This is to request a Class II permissive change for 802.11a/b/g/n/ac + BT4.1 M.2 2230 Type Card,
Model Name: QCNFA344A, FCC ID: PPD-QCNFA344AH.

The major change filed under this application is:

- The subject approved module is being used in a specific host (portable category configuration, brand name/model: see test report).
- Channels 10/11 for HT40/VHT40 and Channels 12/13 for 802.11b/g/HT20/VHT20 are disabled for modules installed in the host platform in this application.

SAR testing is performed to demonstrate compliance.

Please note that software security is unchanged from the original application.

Testing was performed under New Rule (Docket No. 13-49) requirements, based on the module grant dated 8/21/2015.
