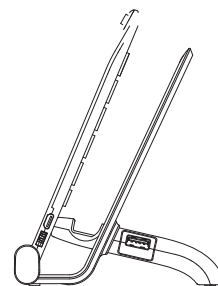
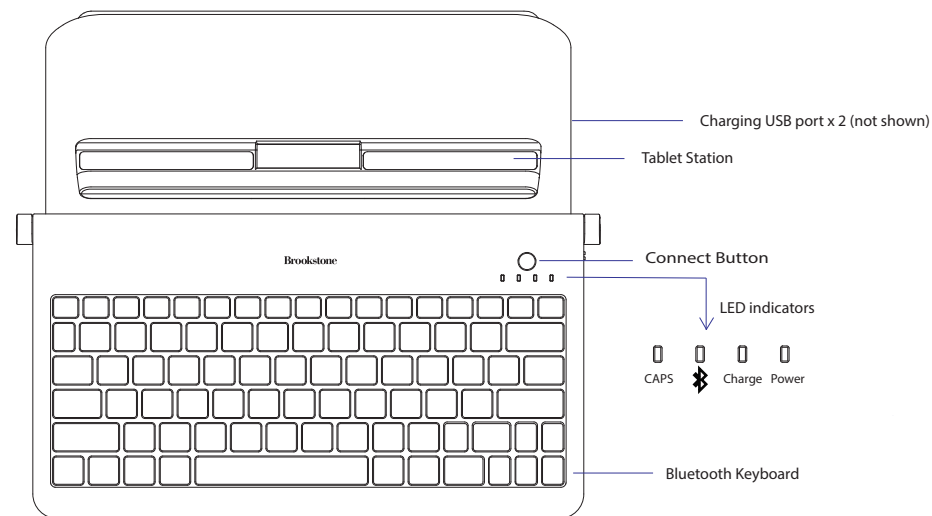

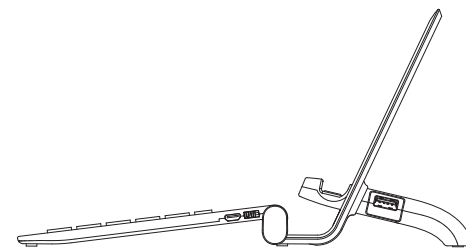

## CHARGING YOUR iPad TABLET

1. Connect the DC adapter (included) to the wall let and plug another end to the DC-IN jack of the Station.
2. Connect your own 30-pin USB cable to your iPad Tablet and plug another end (USB male) of the cable to one of the charging USB ports on Station.
3. You can charge one iPad Tablet and one Keyboard in the same time.

**Note:** The charging ports cannot charge two Tablets at the same time.

## CHARGING THE KEYBOARD

1. Plug the charging cord (included) into the charging outlet at the control panel and into a USB outlet
2. The power and charging LEDs will illuminate during charging, and shut off when charging is complete.
3. The keyboard takes approximately 4.5 hours to charge for up to 90 hours of use.

**Note:** The charging LED indicator will blink when your Bluetooth \* Keyboard Case's battery needs recharging.

## SYNCING THE BLUETOOTH \* TO YOUR iPad Tablet

1. Power on your iPad Tablet.
2. Slide the On/Off switch on the Bluetooth® Keyboard to "on".  
Both the Bluetooth® LED and the Power LED will light up. The Bluetooth® LED will shut off after a few seconds, but the Power LED will remain illuminatd.
3. Press the Connect button on the Bluetooth® Keyboard. The Power LED will illuminate and the Bluetooth® LED will flash.
4. Select the "Settings" icon on your iPad Tablet's screen.
5. Locate and select "Bluetooth" in your iPad Tablet's "General" menu.
6. Under "Devices" on your iPad Tablet, select the Bluetooth® Keyboard
7. The iPad Tablet will now prompt you to enter your computer Bluetooth® password and press either the Return or Enter key using the Bluetooth® Keyboard.
8. The iPad Tablet screen should now show the Bluetooth® Keyboard has connected successfully.
9. The Power LED will remain illuminated while the keyboard is powered on.
10. Slide the On/Off switch to "off" when you are done using the keyboard.
11. If your iPad Tablet goes into standby mode, the Bluetooth® Keyboard should still be synced. If you power-off your iPad Tablet you may need to re-sync. If you use the Bluetooth® Keyboard with a new iPad Tablet, or it doesn't connect properly, follow the steps above to re-sync.

**Note:** The Bluetooth \* Keyboard will automatically go into standby mode after 15 minutes of non-use in order to preserve battery life. Just press any key to reactivate the keyboard.
