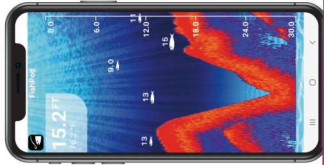

1 Install the FishPod® Sounder Module



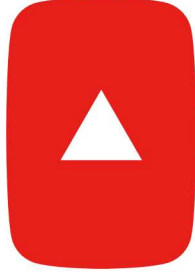
Connect the Depth Sounder Module (DSM) to a 12-volt source that can be switched on and off; the area under the dashboard is typically the most suitable location. Install the transducer as per the instructions applicable for the transducer supplied with the DSM. Scan the QR code in Step 3 for direct access to all installation instructions.

2 Download the App
