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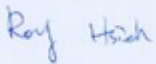

SUBJECT: Class II Permissive Change for FCC ID: PU5AX201D2, Model: AX201D2W

The product has been granted by FCC dated **12/03/2020** under FCC ID: PU5AX201D2. The intention of this application is to enable the modular granted under FCC ID: PU5AX201D2 to be integrated in Lenovo Notebook Computer, Model: TP00111A.

The module installed into host platform mentioned above is electronically and mechanically identical to the original certified module. Software security remains unchanged from the original application. The Original FCC testing on module under FCC ID: PU5AX201D2 was performed with an antenna of higher gain, and the antenna was connected to the module in an open environment. The current host platform under application uses an antenna of the same type but of lower gain and is installed inside the host platform enclosure. The physical restraints introduced by the host platform should have resulted in equal or lower level of radiated emission. Therefore, additional Radiated emission testing is not necessary.



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
