


## 2. Photograph for the worst case configuration



## 3. Sample Calculation

The emission level measured in decibels above one microvolt (dB  $\mu$ ) was converted into microvolt per meter (  $\mu$ /m) as shown in following sample calculation.

For example :

	Measured Value at	<u>378.18 MHz</u>	9.4 dB $\mu$ / m
+	Antenna Factor		15.0 dB
+	Cable Loss		3.7 dB
	Preamplifier		0.0 dB
	Distance Correction Factor *		0.0 dB
=	Radiated Emission		28.1 dB $\mu$ / m
			(= 25.4 $\mu$ / m)

\* Extrapolated from the measured distance to the specified distance by an inverse linear distance extrapolation.
