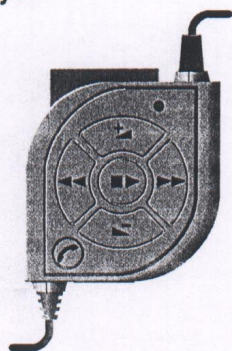

Operation

Keys



- ▶ Play: Hold down.
Pause: Press briefly.
Stop: Hold down.
- ▶▶ Jump forward one track:
Press briefly.
- ◀◀ Jump back one track:
Press briefly..
- Volume:
+ Loud.
- Quiet.

After a pause of about 10 minutes the MP3 player will stop to save energy.

Settings

During a pause, you can make the following settings:

- ▶▶ Change the playback mode:
Normal, Shuffle,
Cont, CoSh (Cont.+ Shuffle)
- ◀◀ Shuffle: Random
track sequence.
- Cont.: Tracks
are repeated.
- + Set individual tones:
Jazz, Klass, Rock, Pop,
Bass, Mono, MP3Di
- and -

Bass: Megabass on.
Mono: Mono mode on, equalizer off.
MP3Di: Equalizer off.

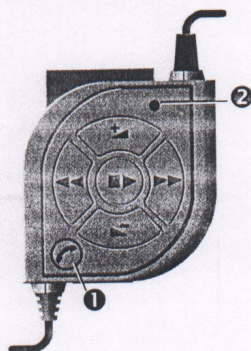
Display

When your mobile phone is in stand-by, information about the current track is displayed when you press any key (except the PTT key) or when a new track starts:

Making a phone call

The MP3 player USB switches to pause whenever you receive or make a call. When the phone call has ended the melody that was interrupted will continue.



Press the PTT key ❶ to accept and end a call.

Please refer to the operating instructions of your mobile phone for setting the auto talk feature.

The integrated microphone ❷ enables you to talk without having to take your mobile phone out of your pocket.

Notes

During a phone call, all keys of the MP3 player are not assigned a function.

A short beep indicates that an SMS has been received. Transmission of an SMS and WAP receipt is signalled in the same way.

Please note that the phone's standby time is reduced when using the MP3 player (the reduction corresponds to that of phone calls).

While the MP3 player is connected to the PC via the USB cable, the keys of the MP3 player are not assigned a function.

The MultimediaCard™ can also be used to transport data other than MP3 music files.

Getting Started

Safety precautions

- Mobile phones must be completely switched off at all times in an aircraft.
- When using the phone while participating in road traffic, always keep one ear free.
- Do not use the MP3 player when the temperature is below minus 5° Celsius or above plus 50° Celsius.
- Protect the MP3 player from rain and moisture, dust and dirt.
- The MultimediaCard™ can be removed. Caution! Small infants may swallow it.

Technical note

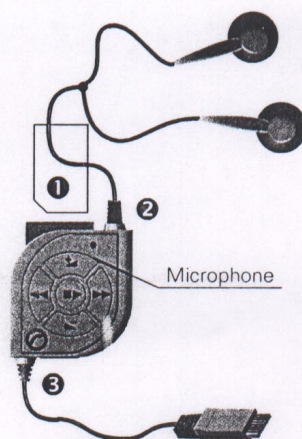
The mobile phones C35, M35 and S35 require software version 18 or later to use the MP3 player. If you are using an earlier software version you must first detach your mobile phone from the MP3 player, then switch it off and on again, to be able to use it.

If in doubt check the version by entering the following key code on the mobile phone:

* # 0 6 # then press the left soft key.

- Insert the MultimediaCard™ ① into the slot at the top of the MP3 player as shown in the figure above (make sure the angled corner is in the correct position).
- Plug the stereo headset ② into the MP3 player.
- Plug the cable ③ into the mobile phone.

A microphone for making calls is integrated in the MP3 player. For good voice quality, make sure that it is near your mouth.

You can use the clip on the back of the MP3 player to fasten it to your shirt or suit pocket, for example.

Copying MP3 files to the MultimediaCard™ 3

You can copy your own MP3 music files from a PC to the MultimediaCard™ of your MP3 player.

Please observe all copyright restrictions.

Installing the drivers

Windows® 2000

No special driver installation is required for this operating system. Connect the MP3 player USB to your PC as described below in section "Connecting to the PC".

Windows® 98 / Windows® ME

For the installation the MP3 player USB must **not** be plugged into the PC!

Insert the CD provided into the CD drive of your PC.

A setup program that can be used to install the driver is found on the CD.

Detailed instructions for the installation are also found on the CD.

Connecting to the PC

Use the cable provided to plug the MP3 player USB into a USB port on your PC.



If the driver has been installed correctly, you are informed that a new unit has been found.

The next steps are executed automatically and the MP3 player USB appears as an additional drive in your Windows Explorer™.

Copying an MP3 melody

A melody in MP3 format has been provided on the CD as an example. Copy this file or other MP3 music files to the main folder of the "MultimediaCard™ drive" or to the "MP3" folder using, for example, the Windows® Explorer.

Copying 32 MB will take approx. 5 minutes. You can also use the Windows® Explorer to delete files from the MultimediaCard™.

During the copy process the mobile phone should be unplugged from the MP3 player USB. Otherwise conflicts between the PC and mobile phone may occur.
