1. Preface

Thank you for purchasing DioGraphy Inc. product. FlashDio (FDU-100A) is a storage device with internal flash memory using USB interface. (It is drive-and-disk-in-one device.) FlashDio (FDU-100A) fully supports both IBM PC/AT compatible computers and Apple computers. Please read this guide carefully before installing FlashDio.

Features

- **Easy to install.** Plug in USB connector to USB port on your computer. It's done! (Device driver installation required for Windows 98/98SE.)
- **Hot swappable.** Once the driver software has been loaded, remove and swap FlashDio with other USB devices without rebooting your computer. When you need to reconnect your FlashDio, just plug the USB connector back into the computer and it's ready to go.
- **Fast and portable.** FlashDio offers quick and efficient way of transferring data to and from your PC. FlashDio is so small and lightweight as to accompany the most demanding portable device user.
- **Trendy design.** FlashDio has the simple and modern look with a transparent body to match with current trend of PC and Mac design.
- **Connect Multiple USB devices.** Using USB hubs, you can connect up to 127 devices including FlashDio on a single USB port.
- **Compatibility.** Compatible with both IBM PCs and Apple computers.

2. Installation

A. Windows Users

a. For Windows 98/98SE

- ① Turn your computer on and start Windows 98.
- ② Connect FlashDio to USB port of your computer or USB hub already connected to your computer.
- ③ Insert Installation CD-ROM included in the package into your CD-ROM drive.
- ④ “Add New Hardware Wizard” will appear on your monitor automatically, then click “Next” button.
- ⑤ Choose “Search for the best driver for your device (recommended)”, and then click “Next” button.
- ⑥ Check “CD-ROM drive” and uncheck others, then click “Next” button.
- ⑦ “USB Mass Storage Class Driver” will appear in the dialog box, then click “Next” button.
- ⑧ When the software is successfully installed, “Finish” button will appear. Then click “Finish” button.
- ⑨ “Add New Hardware Wizard” will appear again for “USB Disk Controller”, then click “Next” button.
- ⑩ Repeat ⑤ and ⑥.
- ⑪ “Win98 USB Disk Controller” will appear in the dialog box, then click “Next” button.
- ⑫ When the software is successfully installed, “Finish” button will appear. Then click “Finish” button.
- ⑬ Now FlashDio is ready to use.

b. For Windows 2000 and Windows ME

You do not need to install software to use FlashDio under Windows 2000 or Windows ME. Just connect FlashDio to USB port of your computer or USB hub already connected to your computer. Windows 2000 or Windows ME will automatically load device driver from its own operating system.

B. Apple Users

a. For Mac OS 8.6

- ① Turn on your Apple computer.
- ② Connect FlashDio to USB port of your computer.
- ③ Insert Installation CD-ROM included in the package into your CD-ROM drive.
- ④ “CD-ROM” drive icon will appear.
- ⑤ Double click “CD-ROM” icon.
- ⑥ Double click “FlashDio Installer”. Installer will install driver for FlashDio.
- ⑦ Restart computer.

b. For Mac OS 9.0 and higher

You do not need to install software to use FlashDio under Mac OS 9.0 or above. Just connect FlashDio to USB port of your Apple computer. Mac OS 9.0 or above will automatically load device driver from its own operating system.
