




Setup & Operation

Power on/ Power off

Automatically power on when the motor connects to the power :


Blue light flashes 4 times, and buzzer sounds twice.




Power on: Press the button for 3 seconds. Blue light flashes 4 times, and buzzer sounds twice.

Power off: Press the button for 3 seconds. Red light flashes 4 times.


Remote Pairing




Make sure the motor is powered on. Press the button 3 times fast to start the pairing mode. Blue light flashes for 1 min.




Press the SET button on the remote. All group numbers on the remote light on and flash slowly.



Select the group to be paired. The selected group number flash.




The fabric vanes rotate if the pairing is done. The light on the motor goes out.



Press the SET button on the remote for 3 seconds to leave the SET mode. Remote light out.


Remote Unpairing



Press the group button on the remote and the paired shade(s) shake.

Press the button 3 times fast to the pairing mode. Blue light flashes for 1 min.

Press the SET button on the remote. All group numbers on the remote light on and flash slowly.



Select the group to be unpaired. The selected group number flash.

The fabric vanes rotate twice if the unpairing is done. The light goes out.


Press the SET button on the remote for 3 seconds to leave the SET mode. Remote light out.




Set Fully Opened Limit




Stack all fabric vanes aside to the fully-opened position.




Long press RESET button on the remote. All group numbers on the remote light on and flash fast.



Select the group number to be set up. The selected group number flash.




Short press the OPEN button on the remote to set the fully- opened limit.



The shade shakes once and the fully- opened limit is successfully set.


Clear Fully Opened Limit




Long press RESET button on the remote. All group numbers on the remote light on and flash fast.

Press OPEN button until all group numbers flash fast to clear the fully opened limit.




The shade shakes twice. The clear is done.




Set Fully Closed Limit




Expand all fabric vanes and rotate the vanes to fully-closed position (privacy).




Long press RESET button on the remote. All group numbers on the remote light on and flash fast.

Short press the CLOSE button on the remote to set the fully-closed limit.



The shade shakes once and the fully-closed limit is successfully set.


Clear Fully Closed Limit




Long press RESET button on the remote. All group numbers on the remote light on and flash fast.

Press CLOSE button until all group numbers flash fast to clear the fully-closed limit setting.




The shade shakes twice. The clear is done.




Clear Special Limit








Use the remote and move the vanes to the preferred position & angle.




Long press SET button on the remote. All group numbers on the remote light on and flash slowly.



Select the group number to be set up. The selected group number flash.




Short press the "star icon" button to set my favorite.



The shade shakes once and my favorite is successfully set.


Clear My Favorite




Long press SET button on the remote. All group numbers on the remote light on and flash slowly.

CLOSE : Extend fabric vanes and keep the vanes at 90 degree

★ : Move to My Favorite

Press Group(1-5, ALL) : Select a group

Hold Group(1-5, ALL) : Identify the shades in the group
