To whom it may concern,

Dear Sir or Madam:

The Miro line of product is a group of 16 different products for the residential market. Some of them use a radio transceiver to exchange data with a proprietary protocol. The WoW line of product is for the commercial market with only radio products. Between Miro and WoW, only the plastic enclosure is different. We need an original certification FCC part 15.247.

The table below describes all the products, for some of them a limited modular approval is needed, and other one a product approval is needed.

The MR reference is the commercial reference for the Miro line of products, W reference is the commercial reference for the Wow line of products. TD is only an engineering reference.

W means white

G means grey

(W/G) means we have 2 different references one gray (example MRD2G) and one white

(example MRD2W)
