I have a few comments on this Application. Please note that further comments may arise in response to answers provided to the questions below.

Comments on response provided

1. In response to question 10 you state "Cloning Mode: it is a function of the device. When the device work in the mode, it can copy it's setup data to the other device(the device must be the same type). So it is easy to setup the other device." As this device is apparently a multi country device used in not just the US, it is unclear if in this process the frequency of operation can change to a non-US frequency. Please verify that when an EU version cannot copy its setup data (primarily frequency settings) to a US device. Please explain how this is prevented.
2. Please explain how the statement on page 2 of the revised manual addresses the requirement that the device cannot be made to operate on non-US frequencies.
