I have a few comments on this Application. Depending on your responses, kindly understand there may be additional comments.

- 1.) The application form, agent authorization letter and confidentiality request are all signed by the same officer at ZTE. Unfortunately, the FCC website will only recognize English names. Kindly provide the English name of this individual in addition to the Chinese. Your efforts on this issue will be greatly appreciated.
- 2.) Please review the block diagrams provided. The "Block Diagram Amendment" does not completely satisfy Part 2 of the Rules. A diagram showing how the GSM module creates, modulates and amplifies a fundamental is preferred.
- 3.) Please view the Label for this device. The 15.19 statement is missing.
- 4.) Please provide additional internal photographs showing top and bottom of all circuit boards, especially including the GSM module.
- 5.) This device contains a USB port which is claimed is only used during programming the device. Can you provide any instructions for how or what parameters can be programmed? This document can be held Confidential if required.
- 6.) Please review the RF specifications located in the Manual. There seems to be some difference as to what or where within the band this device will operate. Please review and correct.
- 7.) The RF power listed on the application form, the test report and the MPE report do not match. Please review and correct.
- 8.) Please provide RF power target tune-up target values for this device during manufacturing.
- 9.) Plots are provided on pages 16 and 18 which show instrumentation out-of-calibration. Please review and correct. In addition, the plot on page 39, lower page is for the wrong frequency band.
