I have a few comments on this Application.

1. Please note that on page 2 of the manual you state that a 'certain' distance must be maintained between the user and the device. However, the SAR was tested at 0 distance. Since the SAR report was tested with the antenna in contact with the phantom, you should remove the last sentence in the statements on page 2 of the manual referring to distance requirements.
2. Please note that since this is a portable device (i.e. capable of being used within 20 cm of the body) and since it was tested for SAR, the MPE statement on page 3 of the manual is not appropriate. It should be removed or restated to reflect SAR evaluation.
3. FYI - Please note that AC conducted average limits are ALWAYS applicable, even if the average limit is shown compliant using QP readings. This means that your tables for conducted emissions are only partially correct in that only compliance to the QP limit has been shown. Please note that even though the QP is under the average limit, BOTH QP and average limits MUST be reported using those QP values. The easiest way is to show compliance to the average limit using QP values. This condition meets the requirement of BOTH limits being met. When the QP is over the average limit then averaging is required.
