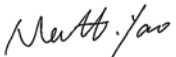
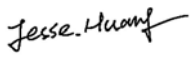

GENERAL INFORMATION

Product Description for Equipment under Test (EUT)

The NINGBO BAIHUANG ELECTRIC APPLIANCES CO., LTD.'s product, model number: BH-T (FCC ID: Q92-BH-T) (or the "EUT") in this report was a Remote Control Transmitter, which was measured approximately: 120mm*40mm*16mm, the input rated voltage :DC 12V, the highest operating frequency: 433.92MHz.

Note: The product's multiple model number: 9907-Remote-T, They have the same appearance, structure, PCB, material and function to the testing products, and only are different for the Model name.

**All measurement and test data in this report was gathered from production sample serial number: 20150916002 (Assigned by BACL, Kunshan). The EUT supplied by the applicant was received on 2015-09-16.*

Objective

This test report is prepared on behalf of NINGBO BAIHUANG ELECTRIC APPLIANCES CO., LTD. All the test measurements were performed according to the measurement procedure described in ANSI C63.10-2013.

The tests were performed in order to determine compliance with FCC Part 15, Subpart C, section 15.203, 15.205, 15.209, 15.35(c) and 15.231 rules.

Test Methodology

All measurements contained in this report were conducted with ANSI C63.10, American National Standard for Methods of Measurement of Radio-Noise Emissions from Low-Voltage Electrical and Electronic Equipment in the range of 9 kHz to 40 GHz. All radiated and conducted emissions measurement was performed at Bay Area Compliance Laboratories Corp. (Kunshan). The radiated testing was performed at an antenna-to-EUT distance of 3 meters.

Measurement uncertainty with radiated emission is 5.91 dB for 30MHz-1GHz and 4.92 dB for above 1GHz, 1.95dB for conducted measurement.

Test Facility

The test site used by Bay Area Compliance Laboratories Corp. (Kunshan) to collect test data is located on the Chenghu Luke Road, Kunshan Development Zone No.248, Kunshan, Jiangsu, China.

Test site at Bay Area Compliance Laboratories Corp. (Kunshan) has been fully described in reports submitted to the Federal Communication Commission (FCC). The details of these reports have been found to be in compliance with the requirements of Section 2.948 of the FCC Rules on November 06, 2014. The facility also complies with the radiated and AC line conducted test site criteria set forth in ANSI C63.4.

The Federal Communications Commission has the reports on file and is listed under FCC Registration No.: 815570. The test site has been approved by the FCC for public use and is listed in the FCC Public Access Link (PAL) database.

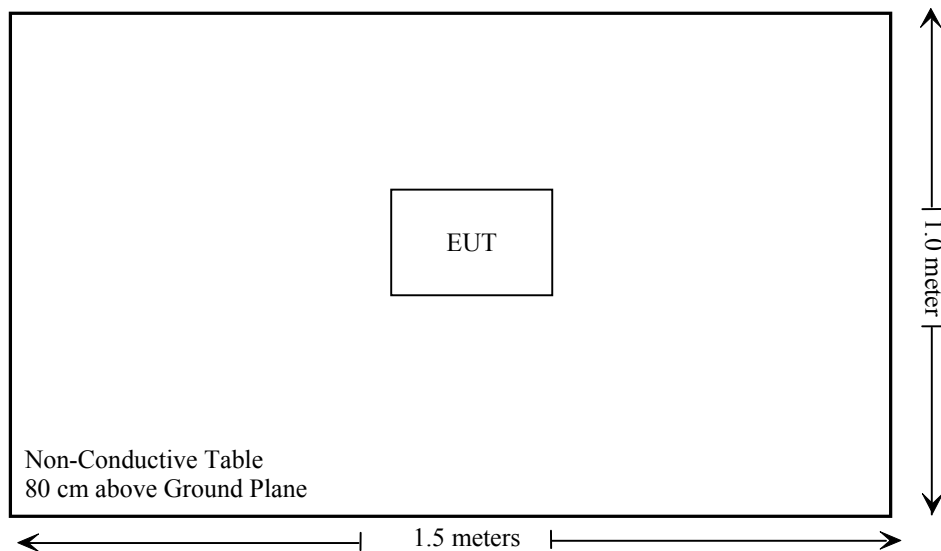

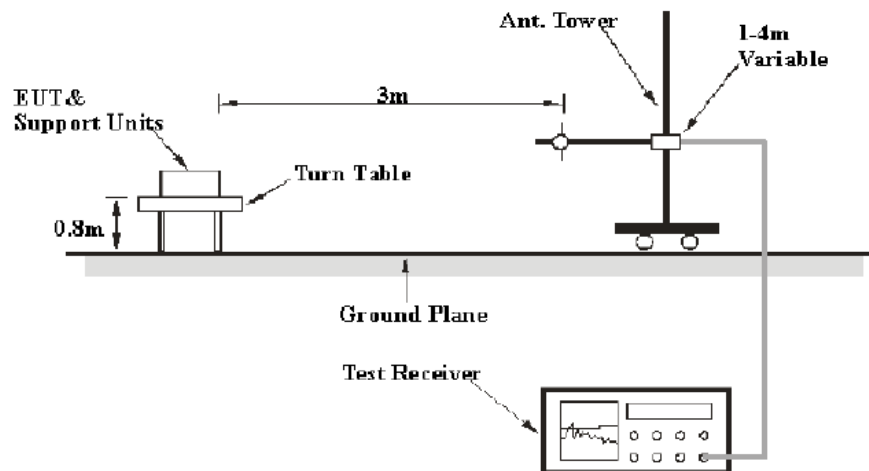
Measurement Uncertainty

All measurements involve certain levels of uncertainties, especially in field of EMC. The factors contributing to uncertainties are spectrum analyzer, cable loss, antenna factor calibration, antenna directivity, antenna factor variation with height, antenna phase center variation, antenna factor frequency interpolation, measurement distance variation, site imperfections, mismatch (average), and system repeatability.

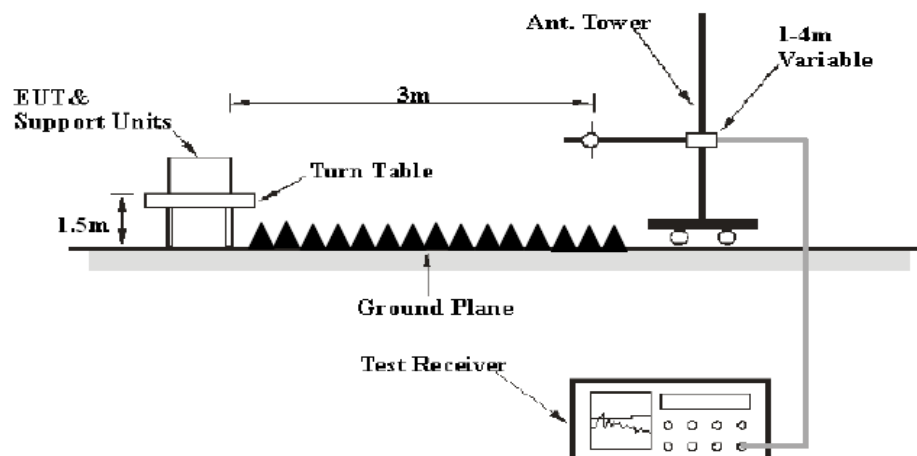
Based on CISPR 16-4-2:2011, the expended combined standard uncertainty of radiation emissions at Bay Area Compliance Laboratories Corp. (Kunshan) is 5.91 dB for 30MHz-1GHz.and 4.92 dB for above 1GHz, and it will not be taken into consideration for the test data recorded in the report.

The radiated emission tests were performed in the 3 meters test site, using the setup accordance with the ANSI C63.10 - 2013. The specification used was the FCC 15 § 15.209, 15.205 and 15.231.

EMI Test Receiver Setup

The system was investigated from 30 MHz to 5 GHz.

During the radiated emission test, the test receiver was set with the following configurations:

Test Procedure

Maximizing procedure was performed on the highest emissions to ensure that the EUT complied with all installation combinations.

All final data was recorded in the Quasi-peak detection mode from 30MHz to 1GHz, Peak detection mode above 1 GHz.

Corrected Amplitude & Margin Calculation

The Corrected Amplitude is calculated by adding the Antenna Loss and Cable Loss, and subtracting the Amplifier Gain from the Meter Reading. The basic equation is as follows:

$$\text{Corrected Amplitude} = \text{Meter Reading} + \text{Antenna Loss} + \text{Cable Loss} - \text{Amplifier Gain}$$

The “**Margin**” column of the following data tables indicates the degree of compliance with the applicable limit. For example, a margin of 7dB means the emission is 7dB below the limit. The equation for margin calculation is as follows:

$$\text{Margin} = \text{Limit} - \text{Corrected Amplitude}$$

Test Results Summary

According to the data in the following table, the EUT complied with the CFR47 §15.205, §15.209, § 15.231 (e), with the worst margin reading of:

6.68 dB at 433.92 MHz in the horizontal polarization

Refer to CISPR16-4-2:2011 and CISPR 16-4-1:2009, the measured level complies with the limit if

$$L_m + U_{(Lm)} \leq L_{lim} + U_{cispr}$$

In BACL, $U_{(Lm)}$ is less than U_{cispr} , if L_m is less than L_{lim} , it implies that the EUT complies with the limit.

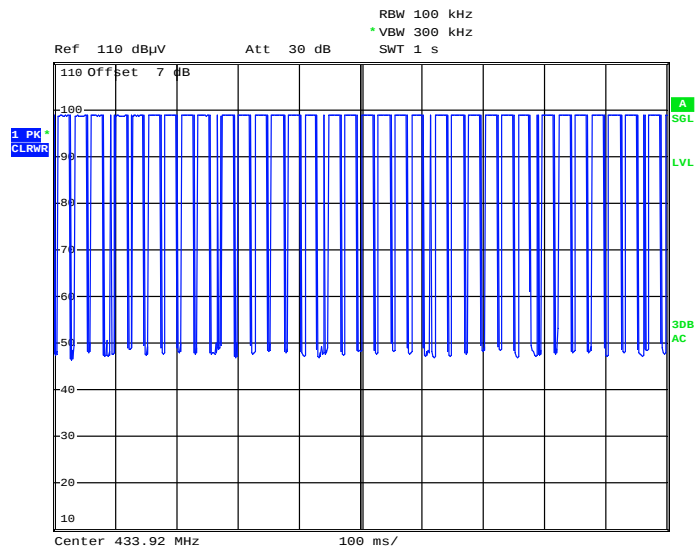

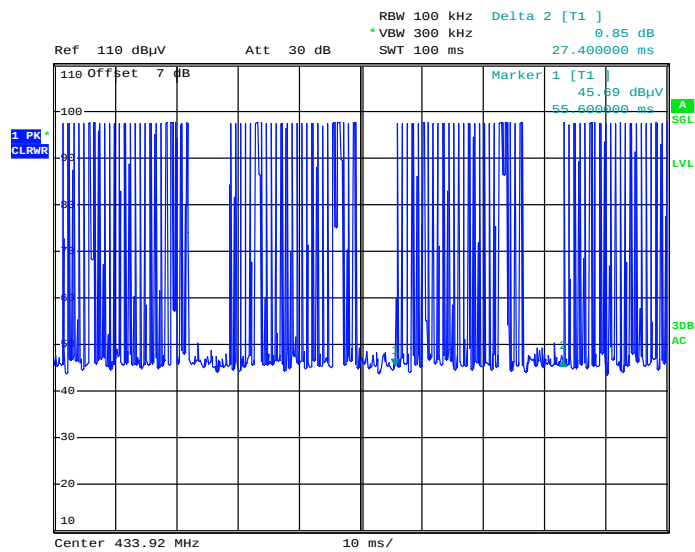

Duty Cycle 1



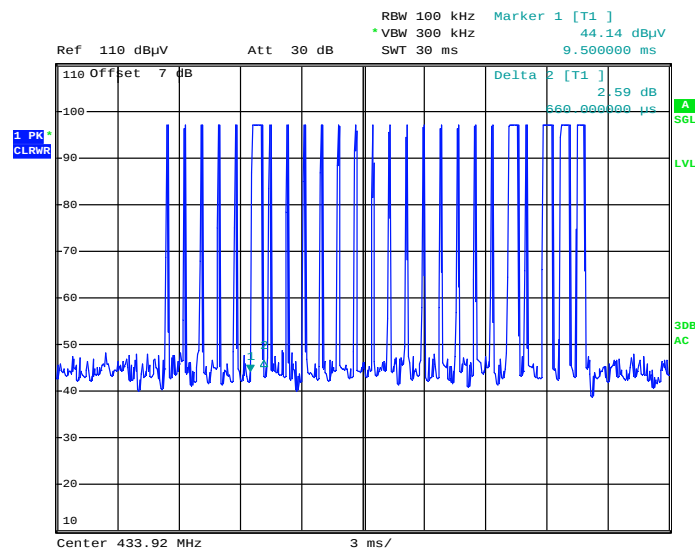
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Duty Cycle 2



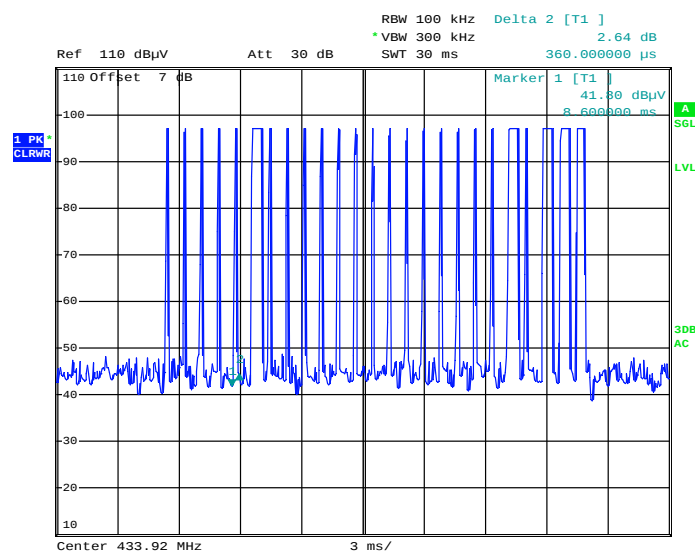
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Duty Cycle 3

FCC § 15.231(c) – 20 dB EMISSION BANDWIDTH

Applicable Standard

Per 15.231(c), The bandwidth of the emission shall be no wider than 0.25% of the center frequency for devices operating above 70 MHz and below 900 MHz. Bandwidth is determined at the points 20 dB down from the modulated carrier.

Test Procedure

With the EUT's antenna attached, the waveform was received by the test antenna which was connected to the spectrum analyzer, plot the 20 dB bandwidth.

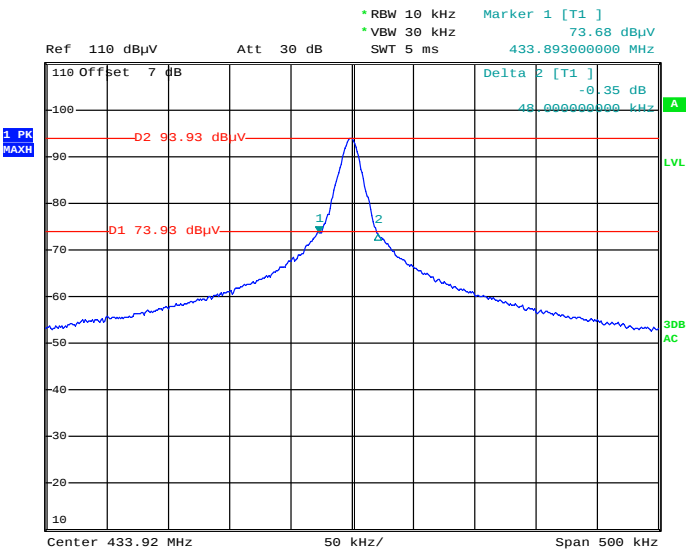

Test Procedure

1. Set center frequency of spectrum analyzer=operating frequency.
2. Set the spectrum analyzer as RBW=100kHz, VBW=100kHz, Span=0Hz.
3. Repeat above procedures until all frequency measured was complete.

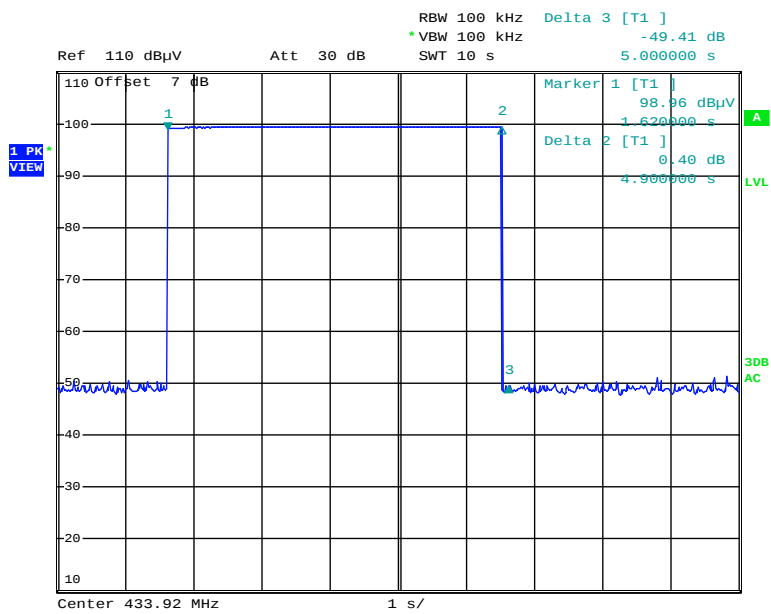
