Jenny, I have reviewed the application for FCC 145.247 Certification of the Integrated Magnetics Bluetooth Module and have some questions.

1) The application appears to be requesting approval for the PC Board module itself. While this is allowed by the FCC the application must be accompanied by a declaration of compliance with the 8 requirements as documented in the attached FCC Modular Approval Public notice. Please provide a document that declares and explains compliance with each one of the 8 provisions in the FCC document. Otherwise, a Limited Modular approval can be obtained, which may mean that additional tests and/or authorizations would need to be completed for each configuration into which this module is installed.

2) There is no clear declaration as to the intended use of this module regarding Portable (<20cm) or Mobile (>20cm) uses. I see that MPE (far field RF Exposure) was performed and saw a 20cm statement in the manual. Is this Module intended strictly for Mobile device applications which would require a separation of at least 20cm from the transmitting element? If this is for Portable use, the full Modular Approval may not be an option due to the EIRP being over the Low Threshold. Mobile only use will require a condition be placed on the Grant.
