This correspondence is in response to your comment within FCC Correspondence Reference Number 24385 and 731 Confirmation Number EA257798.


VPN is looking to certify two new antennas attached to the CISCO PCMCIA card. The original certification of the CISCO PCMCIA card can be found within FCC ID number LDK102035.

For this certification, schematics and block diagrams are only needed for the PCMCIA card which is the radio portion of the equipment. Use of the PCMCIA card within the CISCO Access Point device requires only Declaration of Conformity (DOC) testing.

Dave Case from CISCO has helped clarify this with you during a phone conversation on Friday January 10, 2003.
