

According to §15.247(e)(i) and §1.1307(b)(1), systems operating under the provisions of this section shall be operated in a manner that ensures that the public is not exposed to radio frequency energy level in excess of the Commission's guidelines.

According to TCB Exclusions list, no SAR required if power is lower than the flowing threshold:

Note: EUT doesn't work both BT and WLAN at the same time.
