

User Manual

1. 把車充插入汽車點煙筒，把車充線的 TYPE-C 插頭插入產品背面的 TYPE-C 母座充電輸入插口。

Insert the car charger into the car cigarette lighter, and insert the TYPE-C plug of the car charging cable into the TYPE-C female charging input socket on the back of the product.

2. 手機背面朝產品正面 Qi LOGO 中心放上去，手機即自動被產品穩固吸附。

Place the back of the phone toward the center of the Qi LOGO on the front of the product, and the phone will automatically be firmly absorbed by the product.

3. 接通電源同時手機也即開始充電，達到無線充電功能，而不需要把充電插頭插入手機中。

When the power is turned on, the phone starts charging, achieving wireless charging function without inserting the charging plug into the phone.

4. 手機充電充飽要取下手機時，拿住手機直接往上取出，不需要再拔充電插頭充電線。

When the phone is fully charged and you want to take it off, hold the phone and pull it out directly. There is no need to pull out the charging plug and charging cable.
