I have a few comments on this Application.

1 The FCC specifies that Licensed transmitters held to the ear must have the power on the grant listed as ERP for part 22 devices. You have provided antenna terminal conducted power levels. Please provide the ERP power as specified by the FCC.

The test report has been revised to include erp measurement.

I have a few comments on this Application.

1 TNE devices are classically hand held to the ear. While this appears to be hand held, it does not appear to be able to be held to the ear. The manual states that the hands free kit is to be plugged in before the call is made. However, this does not say that this device is NOT capable of being held to the ear during a phone call. Please unambiguously state if this device can or cannot be operated being held to the ear. If this device can be operated held to the ear, please provide SAR measurements under the head position criteria.

The device should be TNT as stated on the SAR report. The phone does not have microphone or speaker and is thus non-functional without the use of the hands free kit.

2 If this device cannot be operated by being held to the ear, please revise the manual, SAR and EMC report to so state that it is not possible. Please explain how the device is prevents this operation.

I have revised manual and the test report to include this statement. The SAR report already lists the device as TNT only.
