The highest emission was recorded with the rotation of the turntable and the lowering of the test antenna from 4m to 1m. The reading was recorded and the field strength (E in dBuV/m) was calculated. 3. ERP in frequency band 824.2 –848.80.8MHz were measured using a substitution method. 


