

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

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

E173u-63 USB Stick is subscriber equipment in the GSM system. The frequency band of this report is 850M. The E173u-63 implements such functions as RF signal receiving / Transmitting, EDGE/GPRS protocol processing and data service etc. Externally it provides USB interface (to connect to the notebook etc.), USIM card interface. It has an internal antenna. E173u-63 uses Qualcomm MSM6290 chipset and Zero-IF technologies.


- (a) For transmitters other than single sideband, independent sideband and controlled carrier radiotelephone, ERP shall be measured when the transmitter is adjusted in accordance with the tune-up procedure to give the values of current and voltage on the circuit elements specified in 2.1033(c)(8). Connect the HUAWEI E173u-63 USB Stick to the wireless communication tester CMU200 via the air interface. The band is set as 850M.
- (b) Test the Radiated maximum output power by the CMU200 received from test antenna.
- (c) Use substitution method to verify the maximum output power. The EUT is substituted by a dipole antenna. The dipole is connected to a signal generator. And then adjust the output level of the signal generator to get the same received power recorded in step (b) on CMU200, and record the




power level of Signal Generator. Of course, the cable loss at the test frequency should be compensated.




Figure 2. Test Set-up




Figure 3. Test Set-up




Figure 4. Test Set-up




Figure 5. Test Set-up




Figure 6. Test Set-up

6.7.2.3 Limits

According to part 22.355, from 821MHz to 896MHz, for mobile device, the carrier frequency of each transmitter in the Public Mobile Services must be maintained within the tolerances 2.5ppm.

6.7.3 Test Method and Setup

The frequency stability shall be measured with variation of ambient temperature as follows:

- (1) From -30 $^{\circ}$ to +50 $^{\circ}$ centigrade for all equipment except that specified in subparagraphs
- (2) and (3) of paragraph 2.1055
- (a) Frequency measurements shall be made at the extremes of the specified temperature range and at intervals of not more than 10° centigrade through the range. A period of time sufficient to stabilize all of the components of the oscillator circuit at each temperature level shall be allowed prior to frequency measurement. The short-term transient effects on the frequency of the transmitter due to keying (except for broadcast transmitters) and any heating element cycling normally occurring at each ambient temperature level also shall be shown. Only the portion or portions of the transmitter containing the frequency determining and stabilizing circuitry need be subjected to the temperature variation test.
- (b) The frequency stability shall be measured with variation of primary supply voltage as follows:
- (1) Vary primary supply voltage from 95 to 105 percent of the nominal value for other than hand carried battery equipment.
- (2) For hand carried, battery powered equipment, reduce primary supply voltage to the battery operating end point, which shall be specified by the manufacturer.
- (3) The supply voltage shall be measured at the input to the cable normally provided with the equipment, or at the power supply terminals if cables are not normally provided. Effects on frequency of transmitter keying (except for broadcast transmitters) and any heating element cycling at the nominal supply voltage and at each extreme also shall be shown.



(c) When deemed necessary, the Commission may require tests of frequency stability under conditions in addition to those specifically set out in paragraphs (a), (b), (c) of this section. (For example, measurements showing the effect of proximity to large metal objects, or of various types of antennas, may be required for portable equipment.)

The EUT can only work in such extreme voltage 4.75V and 5.25V, so here the EUT is tested in the 4.75V and 5.25V.

Test Set up

Connect the HUAWEI E173u-63 USB Stick to the Wireless Communication test set CMU200 via the connector. Then measure the frequency error by the Wireless Communication test set CMU200. The EUT's output is matched with a 50 Ω load.




Figure 7. Test Set up




