It also provides Bluetooth module to synchronize data between a PC and the phone, or to use the built-in modem of the phone to access the Internet with a PC, or to exchange data with other Bluetooth devices.

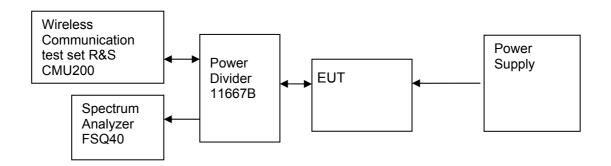


Figure 1. Test Set-up

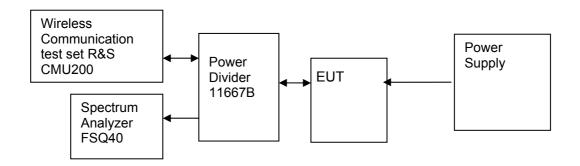


Figure 2. Test Set-up

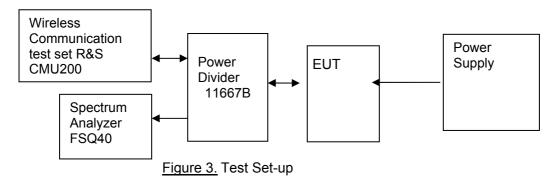

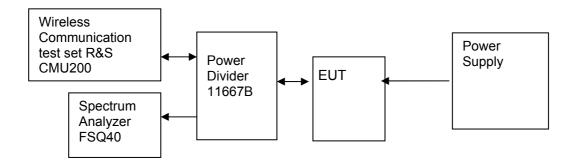


Figure 4. Test Set-up

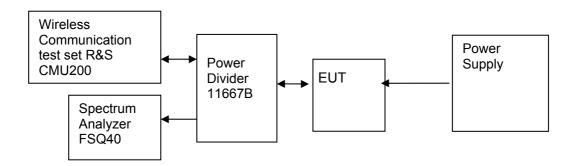


Figure 5. Test Set-up

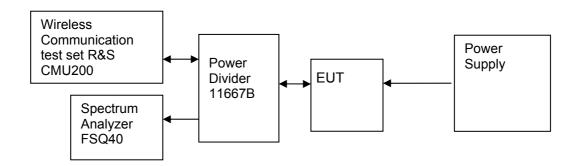


Figure 6. Test Set-up

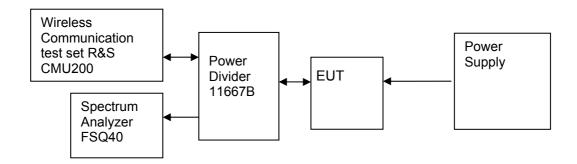


Figure 7. Test Set-up

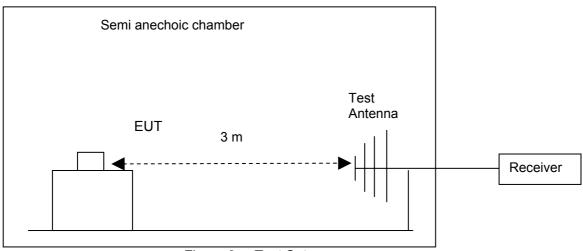


Figure 8. Test Set up

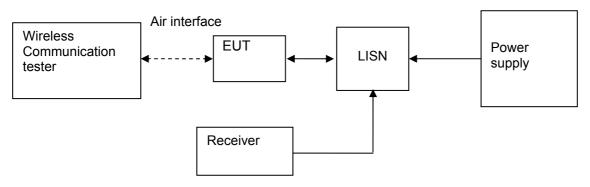


Figure 9. Test Set-up
