• Care and maintenance

- Wearing the headset

Your headset uses a rechargeable battery. You must charge the battery fully before using the headset for the first time.



- Charging the headset



Connect the charger cable

Connect the charger to a wall outlet.



Get Started
Basic Operations

- Turning the headset on/off

	Press and hold	LED
On	The send button for 8 seconds.	The indicator light flashes in blue and red color
Off	The send button for 8 seconds.	The indicator light flashes in blue and red color

- **Pairing with your Bluetooth phone**

1. Ensure the headset is off.

Then press and hold the send button for 8 seconds.

2. The indicator light on your headset will flash in red and blue color. Then set your Bluetooth phone to discover the headset by following your phone's guide.

3. Your phone will find the SBT-7200 headset and ask if you want to pair with it. Confirm this by pressing the Yes or Ok key.

4. Enter a passkey or PIN, 0000(4 zeros), then press the Yes or Ok to confirm it.

* If pairing was successful, the indicator light will flash in blue every 3 seconds.



- **Making a call**

To make a call, use your phone in the normal way when the headset is connected to your phone. After you confirm the connecting tone, press and hold the send button for 2 seconds.

- **Making a voice activated call**

If the voice recognition feature is on, you can make a voice activated call. Press and hold the send button for 2 seconds. You will hear the voice-activation tone. Say the name of the person you wish to call.

- **Rejecting a call**

This feature may be supported if your headset is connected to the phone in a hands-free profile depending on your phone's setting or type.

• Redialing the last number

Press the send button to access the recent call list.

Press and hold the send button to make a call to the last number you have dialed or received.

• Ending a call

To end a call, press the send button.

• Answering a call

After you hear the ring tone, press the send button.

To end a call, press the send button again.

• Switch the call between phone and headset

To switch the call between the headset and a compatible phone, press and hold the send button for 2 seconds during a call.

• Adjusting the volume

Press the volume button  to increase or  to the volume during a call.

• Troubleshooting

Unable to turn the headset on

Recharge the headset

Unable to connect with a device / Unable to work with my cordless phone at home

Your headset is compatible with most Bluetooth devices that support the headset and/or hands-free profile(s). Ensure your device has Bluetooth capability by contacting your device manufacturer. The headset is not designed for use with cordless phones.

The talk and standby times are shorter than normal

The battery can be charged and discharged many times, but it will eventually wear out. If the talk and standby times are noticeably shorter than normal, please replace the battery. Using unauthorized battery may damage the headset.

Something may cause interference with my conversation when I am using the headset

Appliances such as cordless phones and wireless networking equipment may cause interference with your conversation. To reduce any interference, keep the headset away from other devices that use or produce radio waves.

The headset is not working properly

Take it to the nearest authorized service facility for service.
