Gentlemen:

Submitted herewith is an application for equipment authorization of a Television Broadcast Auxiliary Station to be used as a land mobile station for the transmission of TV program material and related communications from scenes of events occurring at points removed from a TV station studio to a TV broadcast transmitter or other eligible services as provided for in Section 74.631 of the FCC rules.

The battery pack, modulator assembly and RF output stages are contained in a backpack arrangement and coupled to patch type antennas permanently mounted in the backpack. The backpack can be worn on the body in the conventional manner or it may be placed on any convenient structure such as a table or bench while operating. Video input is via a separate camera. A separate receiver is provided to allow monitoring the signal if desired. The transmitter is provided with just the patch antenna although multiple antennas are available for use with the receiver.
