After a review of the submitted information, I have a few comments on the above referenced Application.

- 1) Since only the receiver is applicable to the Declaration of Conformity, only the receiver should be labeled for such. Please correct the labeling.
- 2) Please provide a photograph or drawing that show the placement of the label on the device.
- 3) Please provide information to show compliance with 15.231(a)(1)-(3) requirements. The FCC requires plots that show compliance with these requirements. These should show that the normal duration of transmission meets the timing requirements. A couple of plots may be necessary, but based on this device, since it can repeat transmissions every 15 seconds based on measurements it would be recommended to show that a single set of readings that cause an alarm condition cause only 1 transmission (i.e. show only one transmission in 30 seconds and also the duration of the transmission).
