I have a few comments on this Application. Please note that further comments may arise in response to answers provided to the questions below.

1. Please note that the 99% bandwidth measurement for the 1900MHz band WCDMA signal on page 8 of report QMNRN-276\_Exhibit\_6\_Part\_22\_24\_FCC\_0719\_01.pdf shows a video bandwidth smaller than the resolution band width. Please note that the method for measuring occupied bandwidth requires that the video bandwidth be equal to but preferably larger than the resolution bandwidth of the analyzer. Please explain and please retest is necessary.
2. Please note that the resolution bandwidth for the 99% bandwidth measurements cannot be less than 1% of the Occupied bandwidth. As the WCDMA signal is at least 4.1MHz this means that the resolution bandwidth cannot be less than 41kHz. Please note that on page 11 of report QMNRN-276\_Exhibit\_6\_Part\_22\_24\_FCC\_Cph\_FCC\_0720\_10.pdf the resolution bandwidth is set to 30kHz. Please explain and please retest as necessary to be in compliance with the FCC requirements.
3. Please note that the SAR report does not indicate that WCDMA testing was done in accordance to the accepted FCC test setup for WCDMA devices in KDB941225. Please confirm and please explain the test setup as defined in this FCC SAR procedure. If this information is in the report, please provide the page number.
