HOW TO PLAY

START PLAYING

- A. Push the ON/ OFF switch to the "ON" position of the transmitter and the LED lights up. (See Diagram 5)
- B. Push the ON/ OFF switch to the "ON" position of the vehicle. (See Diagram 3)

FORWARD RUNNING


C. Push the Driving Control Stick forward for forward running. (See Diagram 6)


REVERSE RUNNING



STEERING OPERATION

- F. Turn the Steering Control Stick to the left or right while pushing the Driving Stick forward at the same time, the car will turn left or right and run forward. (See Diagram 9)
- G. Trun the streering Control Stick to the left of right while pulling the Driving Stick backward at the same time, the car will turn left or right and run backward. (See Diagram 10)

STOP OPERATION

H. Release both Control Sticks, the vehicle will stop. (See Diagram 11)
