



Description of Monitor & Function Buttons

1. Front View




1. LCD Panel
2. MENU Button
3. SELECT Button
4. Power Button
5. ADJ(ADJUST) Button

2. Rear View

1. Power connector
2. D-SUB Unit
3. VESA Hole for wall mounting or arm
4. Stopper

** Normal Tilt angle will be 5° (Front Angle) and 20° (Back Angle).
If you would like to wall-mount this monitor, press this Stopper to make tilt angle 90° (Back Angle).



3. Description of Function Buttons

In this manual, we will call <DISPLAY ADJUST>, <MISC ADJUST>, <OSD ADJUST>, <EXIT> as Category and each of their respective sub-categories as Individual category.

1) MENU BUTTON

Press this button to bring up Screen Adjustment Menu on the screen.

OSD(On Screen Display) main screen appears when you press "MENU" button once.

Press "MENU" button again to go to sub-category(individual Category) of <DISPLAY ADJUST>, <MISC ADJUST>, <OSD ADJUST>, or <EXIT>category.

Press this button again to move back to the main Category from the Individual Category.

2) SELECT BUTTON

When you are in the sub-category(individual category) of DISPLAY ADJUST, MISC ADJUST, OSD ADJUST, or EXIT category, press "SELECT" button once. The color of control bar below will change to yellow from black color.(This indicates that you can use "ADJ" button to change values of each individual category.)

When you press "SELECT" button again, the color of control bar will change back to black from yellow.(This indicates you can't change the value of the individual category with "ADJ" button. You can only use "ADJ" button to move up or down among the individual categories.)

As the HOT KEY function, press "SELECT" button once to bring up "AUTO ADJUSTING" screen.

3) POWER BUTTON

Power ON/OFF the monitor.

4) ADJ(ADJUST) BUTTON

When you are in Main Category, you can use "ADJ" button to move to up or down in categories.(Category : DISPLAY ADJUST, MISC ADJUST, OSD ADJUST, EXIT)

With "SELECT" button function, if the color of the control bar below is yellow, you can change the value of the individual category by pressing "ADJ" button. If the color of the control bar below is black, you can select the individual category you want by moving the selection bar up or down with "ADJ" button.
