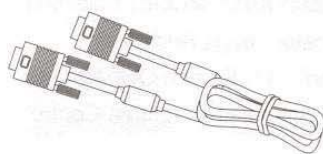

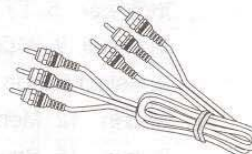

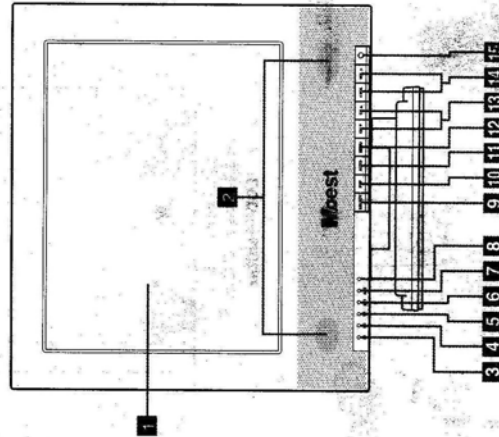

Monitor Configuration

■ Exterior buttons and various connections of LCD monitor are described below. Please refer to the figure and the description of each part below, for each function.

1. Front view

The followings are names and functions of front view.



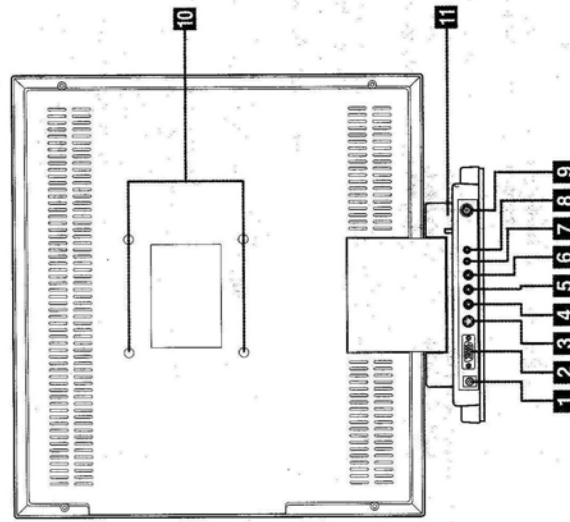
1. LCD Panel
2. Built-in-speaker

1. **LCD Panel**
This is 15.1" TFT LCD screen, and supports 1024 x 766 mode 1,670 colors.
2. **Built-in Speaker**
As a stereotype speaker of 2W x 2 outputs at the maximum, it is connected to sound card terminal in PC.
3. **Power Indicator**
4. **PC Selection Indicator**
This is the button for selecting PC mode.
5. **TV Selection Indicator**
This is the button for selecting TV mode.
6. **AV1 (composite mode) Selection Indicator**
This is the button for selecting AV1 mode.
7. **AV2 (S-VHS mode) Selection Indicator**
This is the button for selecting AV2 mode.
8. **Remote control sensor**
9. **Select Button**
This is the button for selecting PC / TV / VIDEO 1 / VIDEO 2 mode.
10. **PIP Button (or MUTE Button)**
This button activates another small window on the screen. PIP function enables you to work at PC and watch TV or Video at the same time to increase the user's convenience.
11. **Optimal Screen (Auto) Button**
This is the button for optimizing the screen automatically.
12. **Menu Button**
This is the button for displaying OSD control screen on the monitor.
13. **Channel Select Button**
This is the button for selecting TV channel.
14. **Volume Control Button**
This is the button for controlling volume.
15. **Power Button**
This is the button for turning on/off the monitor.

2. Rear view

The followings are names and functions of monitor rear view.



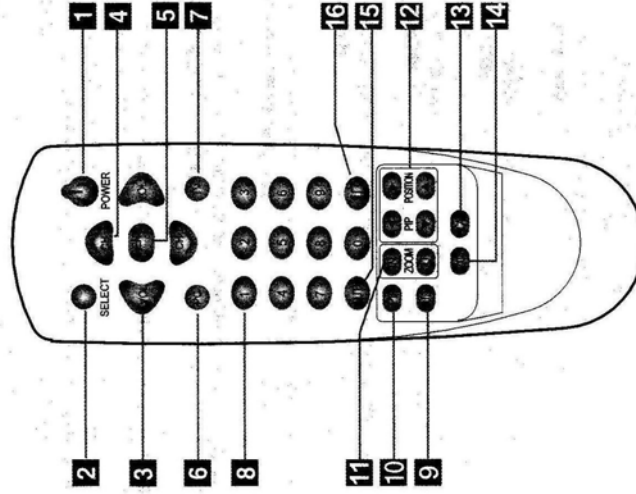
1. Power Input Terminal
2. D-SUB Terminal
3. S-VHS Input Terminal
4. External Image Input Terminal
5. External Sound Input Terminal (Left)
6. External Sound Input Terminal (Right)
7. Audio Input Terminal
8. Audio Output Terminal
9. Antenna Input Terminal
10. Wall Mounting VESA Hole
11. Stopper

- 1. Power Input Terminal**
This terminal is used to connect the power source. Put the plug into 220V
- 2. D-SUB Terminal**
This terminal is used to connect PC and D-SUB connector of the monitor by D-SUB signal cable.
- 3. S-VHS Input Terminal**
This terminal is connected to S-VHS output terminal of external device by S-VHS cable.
- 4. External Image Input Terminal**
This terminal is connected to the video output terminal of external device by RCA cable.
- 5. External Sound Input Terminal (Left)**
This terminal is connected to the voice output terminal of external device by RCA cable.
- 6. External Sound Input Terminal (Right)**
This terminal is connected to the voice output terminal of external device by RCA cable.
- 7. Audio Input Terminal**
This terminal is connected to the speaker terminal of PC sound card by audio cable.
- 8. Audio Output Terminal**
This terminal is connected to the external speaker by audio cable.
- 9. Antenna Input Terminal**
This terminal is used to connect the antenna.
- 10. Wall Mounting VESA hole**
Use this hole to use the monitor by hanging it on the wall.
(Hanging facilities can be purchased separately.)
- 11. Stopper**
If you want to need wall mounting punction, press on stopper and push out your monitor front.

3. Remote controller

The buttons of the remote controller and their functions are described below.



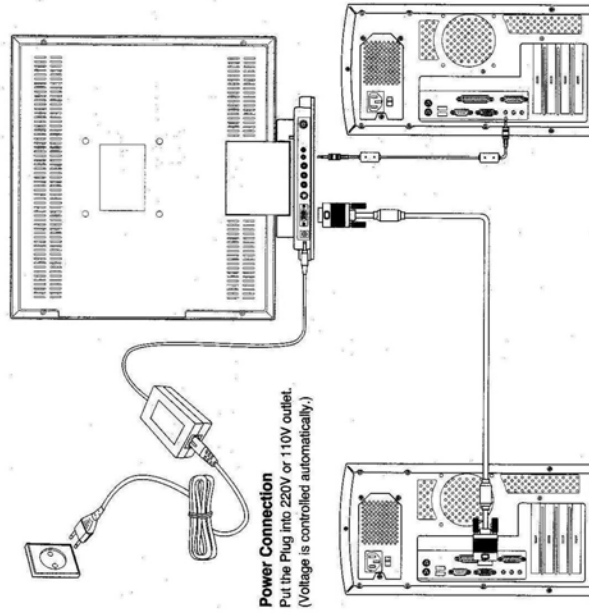

- 1. Power Button** 
This is the button for turning on/off the monitor.
- 2. Select Button**
This is the button for selecting PC/TV/VIDEO1/VIDEO2.
- 3. Volume Control Button**
This is the button for controlling volume.
- 4. Channel Select Button**
This is the button for shifting channel to the memorized one.
- 5. Menu Button**
This is the button for displaying the screen control menu.
- 6. PC Select Button**
This is the button for selecting PC function.
- 7. TV Select Button**
This is the button for selecting TV function.
- 8. Direct Channel Select Button**
This is the button for selecting channel directly by using numbers.
- 9. Mute Button**
This is the button for muting the speaker regardless of volume control.
- 10. PIP Button(option)**
This is the button for displaying TV or video screen on PC. You can turn it off or control its size by using VOL button.
- 11. Zoom In Out Button(option)**
This is the button for closing up/down.
- 12. PIP Position Button(option)**
This is the button for controlling PIP screen position.
- 13. Scan Button**
This is the button for searching channels automatically. (Auto channel search)
- 14. Exit Button**
This is the button for exiting from the menu.
- 15. Auto Button**
During installing the monitor or using it, you can control the screen status to the optimal state by using this button.
- 16. Pause Button** 
This is the button for holding TV screen.

Connecting Monitor

- This is the method of connecting the monitor to peripheral devices.
- ※ Note: Turn off the monitor before connecting the monitor to computer and other devices.

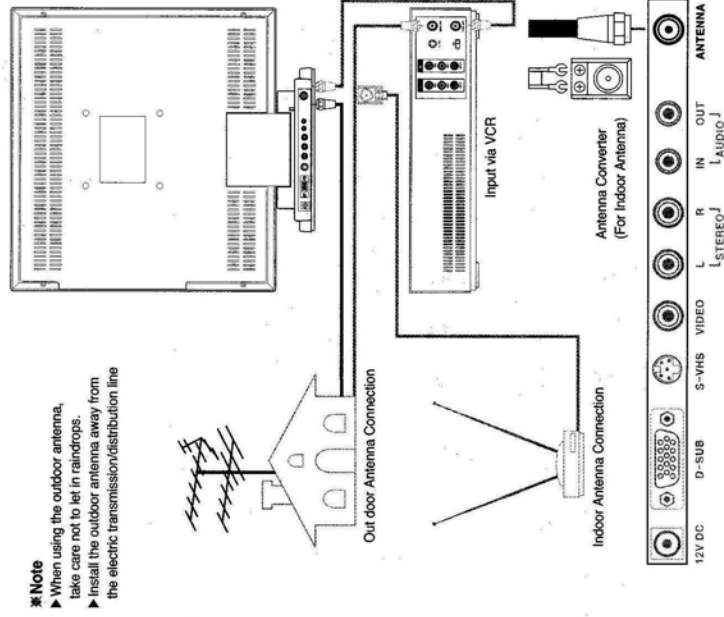
1. Connecting monitor to computer (Basic connection)

2. Connecting monitor with antenna (For watching TV)

Connect antenna input terminal of the monitor to the connecting cable of antenna or cable TV.



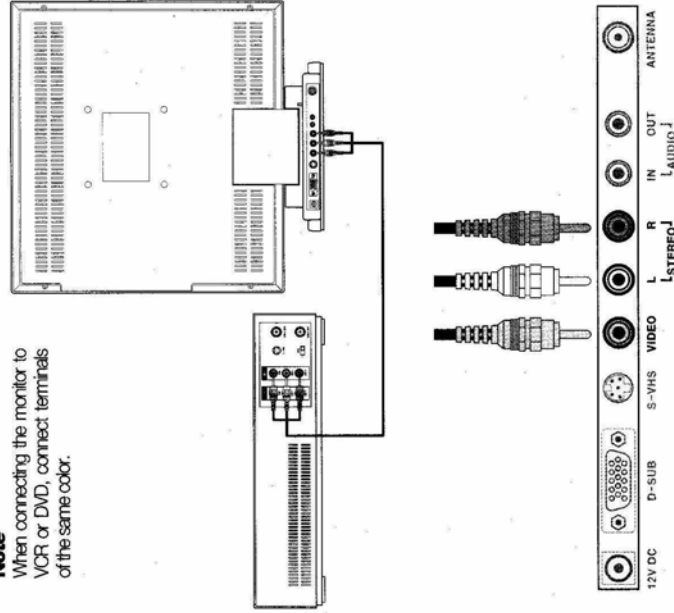

3. Connecting monitor with VCR

Connect the external Image and Sound input terminal of the monitor to Image and Sound input terminal of VCR.

Note

When connecting the monitor to VCR or DVD, connect terminals of the same color.



Descriptions for function buttons

- MB181ATP LCD monitor front is configured with the following function buttons, and their functions are described below.

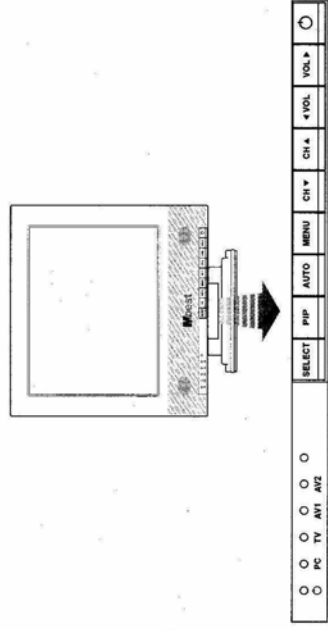


Figure 1. Front View of Monitor Panel

● Description For LED

In accordance with the selection of function within 'POWER' 'PC' 'TV' 'AV1' 'AV2' 'Remoon Sensor' the light green indicator turn on choosing mode.

● SELECT Button

This is the button for selecting PC/TV/VIDEO 1(COMPOSITE MODE)/VIDEO 2(S-VHS MODE) mode.

Descriptions for function buttons and LED

- **AUTO**

This is the button for automatically resetting the screen to the best state.

If you press 'AUTO' button one, the sub screen will appear on the right lower part of the screen as shown in Figure 2 and this screen is automatically reset to the best state.

- **MENU Button**

This is the button for displaying screen control menu.

- **▼ CH ▲ Button**

When watching TV, this button shifts channel to one higher or lower channel. In addition, on control menu, this button selects higher or lower item.

- **◀ VOL ▶ Button**

This is the button for tuning up or down the volume. (Volume control screen, shown in Figure 3-2, is displayed.) In addition, this button also enables you to adjust the value of options while the adjustment menu is displayed.

- **Power Button**

This is the button for turning on/off the monitor. When power is on, the light green indicator is around the button.

- **Descriptions for power LED**

When power is on, the light green indicator is around the button. If VGA-cable is pulled out or SUSPEND-MODE is working, the light green indicator will flicker at certain interval.

Basic working method and examples of function button

1. How to display 'OSD Menu Screen' at the monitor screen?
On any mode of PC/TV/VIDEO 1/VIDEO 2, pressing 'MENU' button to bring up the initial menu for the selected mode on the top of monitor screen.
2. How to clear 'OSD Menu Screen' from the monitor screen?
On 'OSD menu screen', after certain time passes by not pressing any button, it is disappeared.
3. How to move to the desired item on 'OSD Menu Screen'?
When you press the 'CH▲' button or 'CH▼' button while the basic menu is displayed on the screen, you can see that it moves to the 'Adjustment Group' of basic menu and the sub-menu of Adjustment Group will appear.
Move to the Adjustment Group you want to adjust and press the 'Menu' button again to display the bar graph in the sub-menu where you can change the value.
In this state, press '▼CH▲' button to move to the item you want in sub-menu.
4. How to adjust the volume?
As described in Number3, if the desired sub-menu is selected, you can change number to the desired value by pressing '◀VOL▶' button.
5. Examples shown in figure
To help your comprehension, let's change the number of 'Language' on sub-menu from 'Utilities' control item when using it as PC monitor.

- 1) First, press 'MENU' button from PC screen and the basic menu, shown in 'Figure4' and 'Figure5', is displayed.

- 2) On 'Figure4' screen, press '▼CH▲' till the control bar reaches 'Utilities' control item and then, press 'menu' button or '◀VOL▶' button to select sub-menu, as shown in 'Figure5'

- 3) On 'Figure5' screen, if 'Utilities' control item is selected through '▼CH▲', you can change the language by using '◀VOL▶'.

Descriptions for function buttons and LED

● AUTO

This is the button for automatically resetting the screen to the best state.

If you press 'AUTO' button one, the sub screen will appear on the right lower part of the screen as shown in Figure 2 and this screen is automatically reset to the best state.

● MENU Button

This is the button for displaying screen control menu.

● ▼ CH ▲ Button

When watching TV, this button shifts channel to one higher or lower channel. In addition, on control menu, this button selects higher or lower item.
