- 1. Use only on 120V, 60Hz.
- 2. Never disassemble or modify---any changes could void the use's authority to operate this device.
- 3. Not for use in totally enclosed fixtures.
- 4. Risk of fire, do not install the lamp as following:
 - a. in luminaries fixtures controlled by a dimmer.
 - b. in emergency exit lamps used DC current.
 - c. in totally enclosed lamps and lanterns.
